Order to sell the Labor of Construction

In the matter of Ditch Imp. Petitioned for by W. D. Hume et al.

Order to Sell the Labor of Construction.

This day this matter came before the Board of Commissioners in special session, present Jno. E. Roberts, N. P. Cheever, J. W. Bowers and it appearing to the Board that no appeal has been taken from their order confirming said assessments; It is now and therefore ordered that the 31st day of May, 1906, at 10 o'clock A. M., of said day, be fixed as the time for commencing the sale of the work of constructing said improvement, and that the same be sold at public outcry. The place of said sale is fixed at County Surveyor's Office at London, Ohio, and said sale to commence with the working section constituting the north of said improvement, at the hour above named, and from that point to continue to the starting point; each section shall be offered at public sale until all the sections are offered; said work shall be sold in sections of not less than one hundred nor more than twenty-five hundred feet. And it is also ordered that the Auditor of said County give notice of said sale by circulating hand bills.

And it is also ordered and directed that the County Surveyor H. L. McLaugherty attend at the time and place of said sale and conduct the same and receive all bids for the construction of said work; and that he make contracts with the lowest responsible bidder and take good and sufficient bonds for the labor of said improvement conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract so to be made, and for the completion of the work within the time fixed by the contract, and for all damage which may occur by reason of failure to complete the same within the time stipulated in said contract, in a sum not less than double the estimated value of the work and labor of constructing the portion bid off by said contracting party.
