To the Honorable, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned Engineer, in obedience to the direction of your Honorable Body, made on the 28th day of March, 1906, has proceeded in the above matter, and has made a level and survey of the line of said proposed ditch improvement, and set a stake at every hundred feet numbering down stream; and I have made a note of the intersections of lines and boundaries of lands, townships and county lines, land marks, bench marks, and road and railroad crossings; and I herewith make report of the same, with profile, and plat and an estimate of the number of the cubic yards of earth or other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard for each working section, on said report indicated and of each section of one hundred feet.

I have also made, and return herewith, a schedule of all the lots and lands, and public and corporate roads and railroads, together with the name of the owners of such railroad companies, and the names of the lessees operating the same, that will be benefited by said improvement; and an apportionment of the cost of location and construction, in money, to each lot and tract of land, road and railroad, according to the benefits which will result to each from the said improvement; and in apportioning the costs of such improvement the benefits to any lots or lands by diking the same

This improvement consisting of Main Ditch, Lateral No. 1 and Lateral No. 1 of No. 1 is to be tiled as follows: Main Ditch, from Station 0 to station 27+97 with 10 inch tile and from station 27+97 to station 31+66 1/2 with 12 inch tile. Lateral No. 1, from station 0 to station 19+8 1/2 with 6 inch tile. Lateral No. 1 of Lateral No. 1, from station 0 to station 6+23 with 5 inch tile.

All tile must be first class cylindrical Drain tile, and must be delivered on the line of the ditch, each size in its proper place. Any expense incurred by improper delivery will be charged against the tile contract and deducted therefrom at the time of settlement. The estimate for tile includes the furnishing of all necessary gr's.

The grade throughout must be made to conform to the gradient shown on the profile filed herewith, and as indicated in schedule "A" of this report.

The tile must be evenly laid and jointed closely.
 The contractor for construction must put in place

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all Y's and make connection of all laterals.

The tile must have enough dirt placed around and over them to hold them in place but must not be covered until after they have been inspected by the engineer in charge of the work. After which the trenches must be filled full.

Concrete Wall.

At the outlet of the main ditch there must be constructed a concrete protection wall, 6' x 5' x 4 1/2'. Concrete must contain Best Portland Cement 1 part, sand 3 parts and gravel 3 parts. The top and all exposed surfaces must have a finish at least one inch thick composed of Portland Cement and sand in equal proportion, finishing coat to be troweled smooth. This wall must be put in under the direction of the engineer.
