To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Madison Co. Ohio.

The undersigned owners of lands which will be drained or benefitted by the improvement described below, hereby respectfully represent that said improvement is necessary to drain said lands and others along its route, and will be conducive to the public health, convenience & welfare and we respectfully make application for the location & construction of a county ditch between the termini along the route decided below, to wit:

Commencing at a point in the land of the James Dunn Estate, near a large pool not far from the northern line of the land of the said James Dunn estate and the southern line of Charles Mitchell; thence in a northerly direction through the lands of the said James Dunn estate, Charles Mitchell & Flora Guy & Genera Chenoweth to a point in the lands of said Flora Guy & Genera Chenoweth, about one hundred rods from their southern line; thence in an easterly direction continuing through the lands of said Flora Guy & Genera Chenoweth and lands of the said James Dunn estate, to a large pool; thence in a north easterly direction through the land of the James Dunn estate to a School House located at the intersection of the Urbana & Marysville Pikes.

Guy for the location & construction of a ditch filed with said Auditor  
on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D. 1892, on the following route & termini  
to wit:

Commencing at a point in the land of the James Durr  
Estate near a large pool not far from the northern line of the land  
of the said James Durr Estate, and the Southern line of Charles  
Mitchell; thence in a northerly direction through the lands of  
the said James Durr Estate, Charles Mitchell & Flora Guy and  
Geneva Cheenoweth, about one hundred rods from their southern  
line, thence in an easterly direction continuing through the  
lands of said Flora Guy & Geneva Cheenoweth and lands of said

This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, being in session, with the following members present, to wit: A. C. Millikin & M. L. Rea, the further consideration of this matter was resumed, and the said Board of Commissioners having heretofore found that said improvement was necessary and would be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare, and that the line thereof is on the best route. It is now here ordered that an entry be placed upon the Commissioners' Journal directing Eliot Morse, a competent Engineer, to go upon the line of said improvement and survey and level the same, and set a stake at every hundred feet numbering down stream, note the intersections of lines and boundaries of lands, townships and County lines, land marks, bench marks, roads and railway crossings; and make a report, and profile, and plat of the same and estimate the number of cubic yards or other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard for each working section, and of each section of one hundred feet. To the Honorable, the Board of Commissioners of  
Madison County, Ohio.

The undersigned Engineer, in obedience to the directions of your Honorable Body, made on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1892, has proceeded in the above matter, and has made a level & survey of the line of said proposed ditch improvement, and set a stake at every hundred feet numbering down stream; and I have made a note of the intersections of lines and boundaries of lands, townships and county lines, land marks, bench marks, and road & railroad crossings; and I herewith make report of the same, with profile, <sup>and</sup> flat and an estimate of the number of cubic yards of earth or other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard for each working section on said report indicated and of each section of one hundred feet.

I have also made, and return herewith, a schedule of all the lots and lands, and public and corporate roads <sup>and</sup> railroads, together with the name of the owners of such railroad companies, <sup>and</sup> the names of the lessees operating the same, that will be benefited by improvement; and an apportionment of the number of linear feet and cubic yards, allotted to each lot and tract of land, road and railroad, according to the benefit which will result to each from the said improvement and an estimate of the cost of location <sup>and</sup> construction to each and a specification of the manner in which the improvement shall be made and completed; the

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number of flood gates, water ways, farm crossings and bridges, including kinds and dimensions thereof; and such other matters as the undersigned deems important.  Petitioned for by Geneva Chenoweth & Others } Manner of Construction

- 1st. The Ditch must be cut fully down to the grade line at all points.
- 2nd. The Main ditch must have a 7 in. tile from sta 0 to sta 16 an 8 in. tile from sta. 16 to sta. 30 a 10 in. tile from sta 30 to sta. 65.12  
 Lateral 1 must have a 4 in. tile  
 " 2 " " " 6 " "  
 " 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Lat. 2 must have a 4 in. tile.
- 3rd. All tile must be truly and evenly laid in a trench cut fully down to the grade line, made even and straight in the same place bottom so that the tile shall nicely lie on the same plane and at no time must there be a greater space than (1/4) one fourth inch between the ends of tile.
- 4th. All tile must be sound well and uniformly burnt and in no case must there be a warped or crooked tile employed except in turning curves in ditches. and in filling in above the tile care must be taken to prevent their displacement.

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5. All trees bushes, shrubs & etc, within 30 ft. of any of the foregoing tile must be destroyed to prevent their roots from growing into and stopping up the tile.
6. All the foregoing tiling must be strictly first class as to material <sup>and</sup> workman ship.
