Meeting to View.

The Board having proceeded on the 28th day of June, 1898, to the place of beginning of said improvement as prayed for in said petition, and having then and there heard proof of parties affected by said improvement and others competent to testify, in accordance with the former orders of this board as to said matter, and having duly considered the matter do find and determine that said improvement is necessary and will be a benefit to the lots and lands along the line thereof, by furnishing drainage thereto, and will be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare, and that the best line therefor is as follows:

Commencing at a point in a tile ditch on the lands of Jesse Stroup about 80 rods westerly from the Selser and Pancake road; said beginning point being where two tile ditches on the land of said Stroup intersect the ditch described herein; Thence following the line of a tile ditch on the land of said Stroup or as near thereto as is practical to the said road; Thence crossing said road and terminating at a point in said tile ditch 50 feet below the point where said ditch crosses said road and on the land of W. H. Corbitt; Said ditch running in a general easterly direction.

It is therefore ordered that said improvement be granted and the same be known as the W. H. Corbitt Ditch Improvement No. 2.

Order to County Surveyor.

It is therefore ordered that H. L. McCafferty, County Surveyor, go upon the line of said improvement, and level and survey the same and set a stake at every one hundred feet numbering down stream, note the intersection of lines and boundaries of lands, township and county lines, land marks, bench marks, road and railroad crossings; and make a report and profile and plat of the same, and estimate the number of cubic yards of earth and other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard for each working section and each section of one hundred feet.

It is also ordered that said Engineer make and return a schedule of all the lots and lands, and public and corporate roads, municipal corporations and railroads that will be benefited by said improvement, and an apportionment of the cost of location and construction, in money, to each lot and tract of land, road and railroad and municipal cor-

corporation, according to the benefits which will result to each from the said improvement, and a specification of the manner in which the improvement shall be made and completed; the number of flood gates, water-ways, farm crossings and bridges necessary; the amount and size of tile necessary and the estimated cost of the same. It is also ordered that the Engineer locate all necessary laterals.

Said Engineer is also ordered to make and file with his report an itemized bill of all costs made in the proper discharge of his duty under this order; and to file his report with the Auditor of said Madison County in his office therein, on or before 10 o'clock A. M. of the 25th day of July, 1898.

It is further ordered that the time and place last above mentioned is hereby fixed for the hearing of applications for damages arising from said proposed improvement, and of claims for compensation for lands taken for the construction thereof, to which time and place the proceedings now stand adjourned.

In obedience to your order to me, I have surveyed, staked and leveled the county ditch petitioned for by Mr. H. Corbitt and beg leave to submit the following report.

I have set a stake at each 100 feet numbering down stream and noted the intersection of all farm lines and road crossings.

Specifications.

The within described ditch and lateral must be put fully down to the grade line at all points and must be made to conform to the gradients shown on the profile filed herewith and in these specifications.

The main ditch is to be tiled with 8 inch tile from Sta. 0 to Sta. 0+60 and with 10 inch tile from Sta. 0+60 to Sta. 8+75.

Lateral No. 1 is to be tiled with 8 inch tile.

All tile to be first class in every particular.

The estimated cost of the tile includes cost at the factory, hauling and distributing along ditch banks and the furnishing of all necessary gr. for said ditch.

The tile to be carefully and properly laid in the trench prepared for it and jointed within $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch and care must be taken to have all joints well patched wherever the same is necessary.

The estimated cost of the cutting includes the cutting of the trench, the removal of all old tile, the laying of the new tile, the filling in of all earth removed in the cutting of the trench, the deadening of all green trees, bushes &c. standing nearer than 20 feet of the center line of the ditches.

No dirt will be allowed to be filled over the tile until the same has been examined by the Engineer.
