Petition for examination, cleaning and repair of tile in the Beachy County Ditch and cleaning out and reconstruction of Three Mile Run by deepening and widening it.

To the Board of County Commissioners, Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body for the examination, cleaning and repair of tile in the Beachy County Ditch and the cleaning out and reconstruction by deepening and widening on Three Mile Run on the course hereinafter set forth.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing at or near the line between land owned by Orlando W. Bridgman and land owned by Henry B. & Ester Yoder thence following a tile ditch known as the Beachy County ditch in a general south easterly direction through lands of said Yoder, Eulah W. Cupp, crossing the Albert W. Wilson road and then through lands of Agricultural Lands Inc. to the end of said Beachy Ditch in what is known as Three Mile Run thence with said run through the lands of Agricultural Lands Inc. J. Q. Dorgan, Helen Landsittel, Harry Wilson, Lucy Wilson Simpkins, Sam Baber, Ben Straley, Sarah Louise Stoker, Lawrence and Ella Tobin, O. M. & Carrie Lowry, and Eva Stevens to Big Darby creek, or far enough to secure a good and sufficient outlet for lands draining there into.

6--REPORT OF COUNTY SURVEYOR

In the Matter of the Single
County Ditch Petitioned for
Henry B. & Esther Yoder and others.

Proceedings for cleaning out and reconstruction.

To the Board of County Commissioners Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned County Surveyor, in obedience to the order of your Board, made on the 13th day of November, 1945, proceeded in the above matter, and visited the proposed location of said improvement and made the necessary survey for the proposed improvement, as found by the Commissioners, and suitable maps showing the location of the land proposed to be assessed and profiles showing the cutting and gradient of the improvement, and made an estimate of the cost of the construction of said improvement; and set proper construction stakes, beginning at the upper terminus of the improvement, and noted the intersection of the line of the improvement with the land boundaries of separate owners, township and county lines, natural lane marks, road crossings, or purposes, to determine the area, of the land subject to drainage, and to determine the land that will be specially benefited by the construction of the improvement.

I also established, at intervals of not less than one in each mile, in the most practical permanent form, and in locations where destruction or disturbance is improbable, bench marks from which the original levels of the improvement can be established. The relation of the assumed elevation used by me in my work upon this improvement, to the established elevation of the geological survey of the United States, in the County, is as follows: no government available.

I also made a schedule of the work proposed to be done, showing the fall, the depth, the excavating to be done, the location of the permanent bench marks and their actual elevation above or below the base elevation used, the nature of the excavation, and the location of quicksand, or rock, or other special features.

I also prepared a schedule containing the name of each owner of land, with a description of the land which I believe to be benefited by the proposed improvement, taken from the tax duplicates of the County, and have entered in said schedule the proximate number of acres benefited by the proposed improvement, and the amount that said land, in my opinion, ought to be assessed, according to benefits.

I also prepared proper working specifications for the construction of the improvement, including catch basins, retaining walls, size and kind of tile, etc.

I made estimates of the cost of excavating and of the cost of material and divided the construction of said improvement into such working sections as were deemed expedient.

The said survey, maps, profiles, schedules, and reports are hereto attached and made a part hereof.

My estimate of the cost of the construction of said improvement is as follows:
