Specifications of the Manner of Construction.

The within ditch and laterals must be cut fully down to the grade line at all points and must be made to conform to the gradients shown on profile and at schedule "A" of this report. Tile to be carefully jointed within 1/4 inch.

Size of Tile.

From station 23.65 to station 10 of main ditch, 12 inch.

Lateral No. 1 to be tiled with 8 inch tile except where said lateral crosses open ditch where a 12 foot length of 8 inch cast iron pipe will be used.

Filling.

After the tile are laid and accepted by the Engineer the ditch must be filled - using all earth removed in cutting the trench and wherever necessary the banks of the old channel to be plowed in so as to furnish a covering for the tile deemed by the Engineer sufficient.

Ys.

The contractor for construction to put in all Ys and connect all lateral ditches not exceeding one rod in length - the land owner to furnish tile for doing same.

Tile.

To be first class well burned drain tile delivered on the ditch as needed.

Grubbing.

Land owners to have their own grubbing done, or if not done in a reasonable time the same will be done by the contractor and cost charged to said land owners.

Bulkhead.
