## REPORT OF COUNTY ENGINEER

IN THE MATTER OF  
THE SINGLE COUNTY DITCH PETITIONED FOR BY  
JAMES McNARY ET AL

County Engineer's Office  
Madison County, Ohio.

December 12, 1941

To the Honorable The Board of County Commissioners, Madison County, Ohio

The undersigned County Engineer has, proceeded in the above matter, and visited the proposed improvement and made the necessary survey for the proposed improvement, and suitable maps showing the location of the land proposed to be assessed, and an estimate of the cost of the construction of said improvement; and set proper construction stakes, beginning at the upper terminus of the improvement, and noted the intersection of the line of the improvement with the land boundaries of separate owners, township and county lines, natural land marks, road crossings, or other lines or marks; and took and noted necessary levels off the lines of the improvement for contour purposes, to determine the area of the land subject to drainage, and to determine the land that will be specially benefited by the construction of the improvement.

I also established, at intervals of not less than one in each mile, in the most practical, permanent forms, and in locations where destruction or disturbance is improbable, bench marks from which the original levels of the improvement can be established. The relation of the assumed elevation used by me in my work upon this improvement, to the established elevation of the geological survey of the United States, in the county, is as follows: NOT KNOWN.

I also made a schedule of the work proposed to be done, showing the fall, the depth, the excavating to be done, the location of the permanent bench marks and their actual elevation above or below the base elevation used, the nature of the excavation, and the location of quicksand or rock, etc.

I also prepared a schedule containing the name of each owner of land, with a description of the land which I believe to be benefited by the proposed improvement, taken from the tax duplicate of the county, and have entered in said schedule the proximate number of acres benefited by the proposed improvement, and the amount that said land, in my opinion, ought to be assessed, according to benefits.

I also prepared proper working specifications for the construction of the improvement, including catch basins, retaining walls, size and kind of tile, etc.

I made estimates of the cost of excavating and of the cost of material and divided the construction of said improvement into such working sections as were deemed expedient.

The said survey, maps, schedules, and reports are hereto attached and made a part hereof.

My estimate of the cost of the construction of said improvement is as follows;

4000 Cubic Yards Excavation @ 25¢ \$1000.00

## SPECIFICATIONS OF MANNER OF CONSTRUCTION.

In the Matter of the Clean Out

Single County Ditch,

Proceedings for Clean out and  
Repair of the Eliza J. Lewis  
Single County Ditch

The work petitioned for is the clean out and repair of the Eliza J. Lewis Single County Ditch, as shown in Ditch Record No. 10, page 399 etc. and consists of the cleaning out and repair of the same to the original grade line as shown by said ditch record and in schedule "A" of this report.

The ditch is to be made 3 feet wide in the bottom from Station 105 plus 30 to station 63 plus 00 and 2 feet wide in the bottom from station 63 plus 00 to station 0 plus 00, and to have banks of cuts evenly sloped at the angle of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  feet horizontal to 1 foot vertical.

All excavated material to be evenly spread out side of the area occupied by said ditch upon the abutting land, to the satisfaction of the land owners.

The contractor must obtain written statements from the land owners certifying that the excavated material has been spread to their satisfaction.

It shall be the duty of the person, persons or Company constructing this clean out and repair, to make the new channel as straight as possible, staying within the old banks.
