Tile.

24" vitrified Sewer Pipe shall be used throughout the entire length of the ditch.

All pipe, Y's and T's to be first class, salt glazed, vitrified Sewer Pipe.

The estimate for sewer pipe, Y's and T's includes their delivery F.O.B. cars, West Jefferson, Ohio.

Construction.

The trench for receiving the tile shall be cut down to the grade line, and on the gradients as shown on the profile filed herewith, and as indicated on Schedule A of this report. Now, if the said George Reardean shall well and truly perform all the obligations of his said contract and complete the same within the time fixed by said contract and pay all damages which may accrue by reason of a failure to complete the same within the time agreed upon in said contract, and pay for all labor and material and for all debts incurred in the performance of this contract, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to be in full force and effect in law.
