The necessity for and the benefits of the improvements so prayed for is that it will drain and reclaim the lands along the line thereof and adjacent thereto, and will promote the public health, convenience and welfare.

The following is the beginning route and termini of said proposed improvement, to wit:

The undersigned engineer, in obedience to the direction
of your honorable body, made on the 8th day of Febru-
ary A. D. 1902, has proceeded in the above matter, and
has made a level and survey of the line of said propos-
ed ditch improvement, and set a stake at every hundred
feet numbering down stream; and I have made a
note of the intersection of lines and boundaries of lands,
township and county lines, land marks, bench marks,
and road and rail road crossings; and I herewith make
report of the same, with profile and flat, and an es-
timate of the number of cubic yards of earth or other
substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic
yard for each working section on said report indica-
ted and of each section of one hundred feet.

I have also made and return herewith, a schedule
of all the lots and lands, and public and corporate roads
and rail roads, together with the name of the owner
