The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body for the examination, removal of tile and reconstruction of a ditch known as the J. B. Smith ditch but now known as the Bridgman ditch on the course hereinafter set forth.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and term and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing at or near the northerly line of the Finley-Guy road; thence with said ditch, as now constructed or as near thereto as practical, in a general southwesterly direction through the lands of Janice B. Bell, Mary S. Lombard (deceased), land owned by Martha J., Ira S., and Pearl K. Price, Delia Holland et al, Delia Holland and the heirs of Owen Harbage (deceased); to little Darby Creek or far enough to secure a good and sufficient outlet for land draining into said ditch.

WHEREAS, This being the day fixed by said Board in its order dated the 7th day of March, 1949, for the hearing on the petition in the above named improvement, the said Board met at its office, and conducted said hearing by causing the petition to be publicly read, together with all applications for and remonstrances against the improvement, and all applications for change or extension of the improvement, previously filed in writing; and

WHEREAS, Objections to the proposed assessment having been filed by none and the Board having heard said objections and all evidence offered for and against the assessment proposed to be levied against any owner or on any land, as shown by the schedule of assessments filed by the Surveyor and any competent evidence on the question of benefits, and from an actual view of the premises; therefore, be it

And said First Party, for and in consideration of the true and faithful performance of said work and labor and furnishing of said materials as aforesaid, hereby agrees to pay unto said Second Party said sum of twenty six hundred and fifty three and no/100 Dollars (2653.00), in installments from time to time, upon the certificate of acceptance of the County Surveyor and as provided by law. It is mutually agreed that no work or materials shall be charged for except in accordance with the provisions of Section 6490 of the General Code of Ohio.
