This Ditch Improvement begins on lands of Patrick Roddy at the mouth of a 12 inch Sewer Pipe at Station 74+71 in the Armstrong and Withrow County Ditch Improvement and extends on the line of said last named improvement a distance of 729 feet to its terminus at Station 82, thence running with an old open ditch, straightening the route at various points, through the lands of Patrick Roddy, John L. Gallagher and John Higgins to the madder county ditch improvement on the land of said John Higgins.

The ditch must be excavated to the depth indicated by the grade line given in the report of the engineer and the accompanying profile. The Main Ditch must be tiled with 12 inch tile from the beginning at station 0 to Sta. 6+80 (680 feet) and tiled with 15" tile from Station 6+80 to Station 44+67 (3780 ft) to the line between John L. Gallagher and John Higgins. And must be made an open ditch through the lands of said Higgins from station 44+67 to Sta. 61+75 being the terminus of the Improvement at the Madder County ditch.

Lateral No 1, Beginning at the Armstrong Road and extending through lands of John L. Gallagher intersecting the Main ditch at 40+25 is 694 feet in length, and must be tiled with 6 inch tile.

Lateral No 2 Beginning on lands of John L. Gallagher and extending through his land, intersecting the Main ditch at Station 44 is 845 feet in length and must be tiled with 6 inch tile.

All tile must be sound, evenly and uniformly burned, and in no case must warped or crooked tile be used except in turning curves in the ditch, and truly and evenly laid in a trench cut fully down to the grade line, made even and straight in the bottom so that the tile will lie in the same plane, and at no place must there be a greater space than one fourth of an inch, between the ends of the tile.

All of the foregoing tiling must be of first class, as to material and workmanship, and after being properly laid in the trenches the tile must be well tamped and covered with earth to a depth of 15 inches, using the excavated earth for filling. But at places where there is not enough
