The Board having proceeded on the 3rd day of April, 1896, to the place of beginning of said Improvement as prayed for in the petition, and having examined the route and premises along and adjacent thereto, and having heard evidence of parties affected thereby and duly considered the matter do find and determine that said Improvement is necessary and will be conducive to the public health convenience and welfare and that the best route therefore is as follows:

Beginning at a point near the line between the lands of J. M. Byers and lands of Robert Fullerton; thence running in an Easterly course along the South side of the London and Georgesville Pike, and terminating at the Arrow Commanche County Ditch.

We also find that due notice has been given to each person or corporation benefitted or affected by said Improvement.

It is therefore ordered that said improvement be granted and that the same be known as the "Lilly Chapel Ditch Improvement."

County Surveyor.

It is therefore ordered that H. L. Mc Cafferty, County Surveyor go upon the line of said improvement and survey and level the same and set a stake at every hundred feet numbering down stream, note the intersection of lines and boundaries of lands, land marks, benchmarks and road crossings, make a report and profile and plat of the same, and estimate the number of cubic yards of earth and other substance to be removed and the cost per cubic yard for each working section of one hundred feet.

It is also ordered that said Engineer make and return a schedule of all the lots and lands and public and corporate roads, and municipal corporations that will be benefitted by said improvement, and an apportionment of the cost of location and construction, in money, to each lot or land owner, road or municipal corporation according to the benefits which will result to each, from said improvement and a specification of the manner in which the improvement shall be made and completed. Specifications.

The Main Ditch and Lateral must be cut fully down to the grade line at all points and be made to conform to the gradients shown on profile filed herewith.

The Main Ditch to be tiled with 12 inch drain tile or 12 inch 2nd class sewer pipe, from station 0. to station 49. Lateral No 1 to be tiled with 5-inch tile.

The tile to be strictly first class, cylindrical, well burned drain tile or if sewer pipe be used it is to be without cracks.

The estimated cost of the tile includes cost at the factory, hauling and distributing along ditch 100 feet of tile to each 100 feet of ditch and also the furnishing of all necessary Y's or connections.

The trench to be cut carefully down to the grade line at all points, and tile to be carefully laid therein and jointed within $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch. No dirt is to be placed on tile until the same has been properly examined by the Engineer in charge of the work.

When the work is sold the parties who bid it off will be expected to give Bond, according to law for the faithful performance of the work and will not be allowed to sublet any portion of it without first having the consent of the Engineer in charge.

At station 49 a stone wall is to be built of good heavy hand stone and cement mortar, said wall to extend 1 foot below the bottom of the tile and to be 6 x 4 x 2 feet.

All green trees, bushes, shrubs &c standing nearer than 20 feet of the center line of the above tile ditch to be deadened by the contractor to prevent roots from entering and obstructing the tile.

The contractor must, after the tile has been laid, examined and accepted, carefully fill in over said tile all earth removed by him in performing said work.

The Main Ditch from Station 49 to station 51.80 to be an open ditch 2 feet wide in the bottom, with banks sloped $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1.

No part of said work will be accepted, until upon examination it is found to lack nothing under these specifications.

75% Estimates will be issued on completed working sections.
