To the Honorable ,The Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned Engineer, in obedience to the direction of your Honorable Body, made on the 1st day of August ,1916, has proceeded in the above matter, and has made a level and survey of the line of said proposed ditch improvement, and set a stake at every hundred feet numbering down stream; and I have made a note of the intersections of lines and boundaries of lands, township and county lines, land marks, bench marks, and road and railroad crossings; and I herewith make report of the same, with profile, and plat and an estimate of the number of the cubic yards of earth or other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard for each working section on said report indicated and of each section of one hundred feet.

I have also made, and return herewith, a schedule of all the lots and lands, and public and corporate roads and railroads, together with the name of the owners of such railroad companies, and the names of the leasees operating the same, that will be benefited by said improvement; and an apportionment of the cost of location and construction, in money, to each lot and tract of land, road and railroad, according to the benefits which will result to each from the said improvement; and in apportioning the costs of such improvement the benefits to any lots or lands by diking the same in whole or in part, have been by me considered with other benefits; and a specification of the manner in which the improvement shall be made and completed; the number of flood gates, water ways, farm crossings and bridges, including kinds and dimensions thereof; and such other matters as the undersigned deems important. Specifications of the Manner of Construction.

This improvement consists of taking up the tile now in Lateral No. 3 of the Glade Run Ditch Improvement and replacing them with other tile as follows:

From Station 0 to 9.82, 8 inch; Station 9.82 to Station 16.42, 10 inch and from Station 16.42 to Station 56.92, 12 inch tile.

Also the construction of the new laterals, Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 of said Lateral No. 3. All of said laterals of No. 3 are to be tiled with 6 inch tile.

The trench for receiving the tile shall be cut down to the grade line and on the gradients as shown on the profile, filed herewith, and as indicated in Schedule "A" of this report.

The tile shall be laid uniformly and closely jointed so as to prevent sediment from entering the tile at the joints.

The tile must not be covered until after they have been inspected by the Engineer in charge of the work.

After inspection, if found satisfactory, the trench shall be filled full by the Contractor.

The tile now in said Lateral No. 3 shall be taken up and ricked up on the bank of the ditch. Said tile to become the property of the land-owners on whose lands they are found.

If at any time during the construction of the ditch, the established grade is found to be above the tile, the right to change the grade is reserved.

The tile shall be well burned, cylindrical, drain tile and shall be delivered each size in its proper place on the line of the ditch.

The Ys shall be vitrified sewer pipe and each one delivered in its proper place.

A clear right-of-way of 30 feet on each side of ditch is reserved for delivering tile and constructing ditch.
