Petition for location, Relocation and reconstruction of part of the Emma E. Welsh County ditch.

To the Board of County Commissioners, Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body for the relocation and reconstruction of part of the Emma E. Welsh County ditch on the course hereinafter set forth.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit: Commencing at a point in said ditch on land now owned by Edgar G. Smith at or near station 64-50 thence following said ditch in a general northerly direction through lands of said Smith and lands of Albert Phifer Parker far enough to secure a good and sufficient outlet for lands draining into said ditch.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for: Removal of the present bulkhead the removal of a certain batch basin above said old bulkhead, the building of a new bulkhead filling of wash and repairing and relaying of tile and cleaning out the open ditch far enough to secure a good and sufficient outlet.

F--Specifications of the Manner of Construction

In the Matter of the Single County Ditch Petitioned for by Edgar G. Smith

Surveyor's Office, Madison County, Ohio. Proceedings for relocation, reconstruction, of part of the Emma G. Welsh county Ditch.

Lateral No. 2

At Stations 9-75 - 13-04 - 52-70 and 53-20 Remove broked and damaged 18" tile and relay with first class tile to original grade and backfill all excavation and wash.

At stations 26-00 and 42-65 remove damaged tile and replace with 18" corrugated pipe 16 feet required at station 26 and 26 ft. required at station 42-65 at station 42-65 ends of pipe shall be protected from wash with 8" grouted riprap main ditch.

Broken tile shall be removed and replaced with good quality tile at station 63 to 63-10

At concrete airwell 10" and 15" tile shall be layed continous through concrete well--sides of concrete shall be cut off--18" below present top and backfilled to regular section of the ditch.

WILSON COUNTY DITCH

All above repair work shall be paid for at the bid price for actual work done. Work at bulkhead shall be done in accordance with plans attached and made a part of this contract.

The main open ditch beginning at station 64-37 and extending to station 105.

The open ditch shall be cut to the grade line and gradients shown on Schedule A. of this report and shall have a bottom width and slopes as shown on the cross sections. All excavated material shall be deposited well back of the banks and evenly spread to the satisfaction of the land owners. Signed statements signifying their approval of the same shall be obtained by the contractor and submitted to the County Engineer before final estimate will be issued. All trees, roots, or brush which will obstruct the free flow of water in the ditch shall be removed and disposed of. The cost of such work is to be included in the price bid for.

Excavation--

It shall be the duty of the land owners to remove all fences, water gaps, etc. that will interfere with the contractor in the progress of this work. Thereby relieving the contractor of any obligations in this matter, but the contractor shall use due care so as not to cause unnecessary damage to fences, water gaps or bridges--and in case of such damage caused by the contractor, he shall be held liable for the same.

In depositing of excavated material care shall be taken that no draw or place where surface water flows into the ditch shall be obstructed so as to prevent the free flow of water into the ditch.

A clear right of way of 50 feet on each side of the ditch is reserved for the contractor. This width shall be measured from the top of the ditch banks.

In the Matter of the Single County Ditch Petitioned for by Edgar G. Smith.

The Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 15 day of September, 1947, at the office of the Commissioners with the following members present:

Rodney Plymell
R.W. Armstrong

Mr. Armstrong moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

Whereas, Said Board has heretofore, by Resolution duly passed on the 3 day of June, 1946, affirmed its former order finding in favor of the improvement of the County Ditch, petitioned for by Edgar G. Smith; and

Whereas, It is now deemed necessary to issue and sell \$266.34 of notes under authority of Section 2293-24 of the General Code of Ohio, and "The Uniform Bond Act" for the purpose of providing funds in anticipation of the levy of assessments according to benefits or of the issuance of bonds for the improvement of said County Ditch; and

Whereas, The County Auditor has certified the maximum maturity of said notes to be five years, which maximum maturity does not exceed the estimated life or usefulness of the improvement fixed by Section 2293-9 of the General Code of Ohio; and

Whereas, This Board has heretofore, by Resolution duly passed on the 3 day of June, 1946, determined that five years shall be the period of time, in semi-annual installments, as taxes are paid, given the owners of land benefited to pay the assessment that may be made for the improvement; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, that in the judgment of said Board of County Commissioners, it is now necessary in anticipation of the levy of assessments according to benefits of the issuance of bonds to issue and sell the notes of said County under and by virtue of the authority of Section 2293-24 of the General Code of Ohio and "The Uniform Bond Act" in the aggregate sum of Two Hundred Sixty Six and 34/100--- Dollars (\$266.34), not exceeding in amount that portion of the estimated cost of the improvement for which the assessment is levied, to provide a fund for the payment of the cost and expense of the improvement of said County Ditch according to the terms of the Resolution above referred to: and be it further

Resolved, That said note shall be dated the 1 day of October, 1947, and shall be in the denomination of Two Hundred Sixty Six and 34/100 Dollars (\$266.34) and shall be numbered three.

Said note shall bear interest at the rate of four per centum per annum until paid, and the interest on said note shall be payable on the 1 day of April and the 1 day of October, 1948 and until the principal sum of said note is paid and as evidenced by interest coupons attached thereto. Said note shall not be issued for a longer period of time than two years from date thereof and shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of said County at London, Ohio, upon presentation and surrender of said notes and interest coupons as they respectively mature. Said note shall be redeemable at any interest period.

Said note shall be due and payable as follows: No. 3 Date April 1, 1949 Amount \$266.34

Said note shall specify on their face the purpose for which they are issued, and that they are issued in pursuance of this resolution and under authority of the General Laws of the State of Ohio, particularly Section 2293-24 of the General Code of Ohio and "The Uniform Bond Act", and shall be full general obligations of said Madison County, and for the full amount thereof, and the full faith, credit and revenue of said County are hereby pledged for the payment of the principal and interest thereof at maturity.

Said note shall be signed by the members of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, and the County Auditor and bear his seal, and the interest coupons shall have the facsimile signature of said County Auditor printed or lithographed thereon; and be it further

Resolved, That said note shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds hereafter issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments and all of the assessments collected for the improvement shall be applied to the payment of the notes and interest thereon until both are fully paid; and be it further

Resolved, That there shall be and is hereby levied on all the taxable property in Madison County, Ohio, in addition to all other taxes a direct tax annually during the years while such notes run, not less than that which would have been levied if bonds had been issued without the prior issue of such notes.

Said tax shall be, and is hereby ordered computed, certified, levied and extended upon the tax duplicate, and collected by the same officers, in the same manner and at the same time that taxes for general purposes for each of said years are certified, levied, extended and collected. Said tax shall be placed before and in preference to all other items and for the full amount thereof. The funds derived from said tax levies required shall be placed in a separate and distinct fund, which, together with all interest collected on the same, shall be irrevocably pledged for the payment of the interest and principal of said note, when and as the same fall due.

It is hereby determined that all acts, conditions and things necessary to be done precedent to and in the issuance of said note in order to make the same legal, valid and binding obligations of said County have been done, have happened and have been performed in regular and due form as required by law and that the tax for the payment of the principal and interest as the same falls due and is payable does not exceed any limitations of taxation of said County, and that the amount of this note issue does not exceed any limitation of indebtedness as fixed by law.

Mr. Plymell seconded the resolution and the roll being called upon its adoption, the vote resulted as follows:
