To the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body for the relocation, reconstruction, construction, deepening and widening of the Yutzy County ditch and extension thereof for a sufficient outlet on the course hereinafter set forth.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing at the concrete bulkhead at the end of the tile in the Yutzy County ditch on the south side of the Price-Hilliards County road; thence following an open ditch on the lands of Homer N. Yutzy, H.H. Kauffman, Levi Gingerich, Noah Christner, crossing said road and through land of Grace Price and Mary Price Rickards; thence crossing said road and thence through land of said Rickards, John W. Price, crossing State Route No. 42 and through said Price, Eli E. and Ida Yutzy, William Walker in a general easterly direction far enough to secure a good and sufficient outlet for all lands draining into said ditch.

Your petitioners also ask for the location and construction of any and all necessary lateral

Resolved, That the County Surveyor be and he is hereby directed to cause to be made the necessary survey for the proposed improvement, upon the foregoing plan and line, and suitable maps showing the location of the land proposed to be assessed, and profiles showing the cuttings and gradient of the improvement, and make and estimate of the cost of the construction and said improvement; and set proper construction stakes, beginning at the upper terminus of the improvement, and perform such other duties as required by Section 6454 of the General Code of Ohio; and be it further

F--Specifications of the Manner of Construction

In the Matter of the Single  
County Ditch Petitioned for  
by Homer N. Yutzy and others.

County Engineer's Office  
Madison County, Ohio  
Proceedings for the location,  
altering and reconstruction.

Main Ditch.

The main ditch from Station 58 plus 25 at the Bulkhead shall be cut to the grade line and gradient shown in Schedule "A" of this report and shall have a bottom width of five feet with side slopes of one and one half to one. Existing ditch banks shall not be disturbed more than is necessary to obtain required bottom width.

All excavated materials shall be evenly spread well beyond the tops of the ditch banks and this must be done to the satisfaction of the land owners. Signed statements from these land owners signifying their approval of the same must be obtained by the contractor and submitted to the County Engineer before final estimate will be issued.

It shall be the duty of the land owners to look after and remove all fences, crossing or along the ditch, take out, remove and replace water gates that will interfere with the construction of the ditch, thereby relieving the contractor of any obligation in this matter. But in case any land owner shall fail or refuse so to certify his approval, then the County Engineer shall be the judge of when the work is properly done.

The contractor shall exercise due care as not to cause unnecessary damage to fences, water gaps or bridges. In case of damage of this kind being caused by the contractor, he shall be held liable for the same. A clear right of way of 50 feet on each side of the ditch is reserved for the construction. This width shall be measured from the top of the ditch banks. In depositing or placing excavated material, care is to be taken that no draw or place where surface water enters the ditch shall not in any manner be interfered with. Repairs to existing 22-inch tile ditch.

The existing 22 inch tile ditch behing the bulkhead shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the County Engineer and payment made for actual work done at the unit price bid.

Lateral No. 1

The trench shall be cut to a uniform grade as shown on the profile and 12-inch tile laid with joints open 1/4 inch. Care shall be taken that open joints on curves shall be covered with tile.

All excavated material to be filled over the tile. All brush and roots shall be grubbed 20 feet from the center of the tile ditch.

No storm ditch will be required over the tile ditch.

The backfill over the corrugated pipe crossing Price Hilliard road shall be compacted to a density of not less than 90%. Hand tamping will be permitted in layers not exceeding 8 inches in depth.

Resolved, That the County Surveyor be and he is hereby directed to give at least two weeks' public notice as required by law of the time when and the place where bids will be received and furnishing any material for the improvement, or for the construction of the improvement, or any part thereof, and in case manufactured material is required for the construction of the improvement, the Surveyor is hereby directed to send copies of the notice by mail to dealers and manufacturers, and all bids shall be received at the office of the County Auditor; and be it further

Resolved, That, whereas the estimated cost of the construction and material required in said improvement exceeds one thousand dollars, the notice of said letting be given by posting at the front door of the County Court House, and advertisement shall also be made in two successive weekly issues of a newspaper printed and in general circulation in said County, and be it further

Resolved, That said County Surveyor be and he is hereby directed to attend at said time and place so advertised by him and receive all bids submitted; and be it further

Resolved, That authority be and the same is hereby given to said County Surveyor to receive bids by public outcry, instead of sealed bids, such bids being taken separately for work and for material, and in accordance with the requirements of Section 6481 of the General Code of Ohio.
