One beginning on the East side of Darby Creek near James Gullard East line on the County line and running from thence Northerly up said creek on the most suitable ground, crossing Sugar Run, continuing on by John Kortens until it shall intersect the said Road.

The other Beginning at the termination of a Road running from the Scioto River below Dublin to the westerly boundary of Franklin County and running from thence a westerly course until it shall strike the State Road on the west side of Darby Creek =

Whereupon Tho^s Tillgoe, Jeremiah Converse, Albert Newton, Oliver and Samuel Milliken Surveyors were appointed to Meet at Gullard Mill on the 8th this inst & proceed to view, Survey, & Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to law =

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view & survey of a Road, commencing at the School house in Darby Township near Daniel Keys & from thence by Daniel Snodgrass to Patrick's Mills from thence on a direction to Little Darby bridge to the County line = Whereupon, James McMann, Henry King & John Kennedy (viewers) & Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Daniel Keys on the 24th this inst & proceed view survey and Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to law =

Dec 3^d 1838

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a vacation of the County Road leading from London to the crossing of Bear Creek at John Davidson's Road & laid over until the next Meeting of this board

1839 March 5th Ordered by the Commissioners that so much of the said Road as lays between John Lott's & John Davidson's Crossing of Bear Creek be vacated
