

June 2^d 1834

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented by James Stubblefield praying for an alteration of the County Road, which commenced in A. Stewart's pasture running by Joseph Thernal, as follows to wit beginning at A. Stewart's line and running with said line & course, thence along the Road now used to J. Mifflin's line, thence with said line and the course thereof to said Road again

Whereupon David Bye, Isaac B. Fisher & Peter Counts, Brewer and Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed to view Survey, and Make Report thereof according to law provided the same is done at the expense of the petitioner; to Meet at Richard King's on the 14th this inst

Dec 1st 1834 Return favorable and Road:

March 1835 The aforesaid alteration is ordered to be recorded, and opened according to law, and the old way vacated as follows: Beginning at a point where the new Road, between the pasture of A. Stewart and E. Stubblefield intersects the old Road and runs from thence with the line between said pasture and also with the new Road, N 48 W. 320 poles, 1st Mile tree; same course 132 p. to the South west corner of John Payton's Survey N 12 1/2 E, thence with the line between the land of James Mifflin & Richard King West 160 poles, intersecting the said Chelliothe & Springfield Road:

June 2^d 1834

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for view of to be appointed to locate a Road commencing at the Chelliothe Road, at or near the East corner of John Kivour's pasture fence, thence to David Difebaugh's Mill, thence on the line of Jonathan Morain & Adam Difebaugh to the corner of Phemal Strain & Thos Robinson thence with said line to the Palestine Road, thence with said Road to the line of John Smith & Skell, thence with said line to their North corner, thence on the nearest and best road to the County line at the Mouth of David Manthelan

Whereupon Wm Woods & Wm Woods Jr. & Wm Crath Brewer and Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Wm Bruffett's on the 23^d this instant to view Survey & Make return according to law;

1834 Dec 1st Report returned favorable and Road

1835 March 2^d No objections being made the following Road, is ordered to be recorded & opened according to law, to wit: Beginning at a point on the Road leading from Chelliothe to Lonsden, where the North line of Survey N 62 08 E. crosses said Road, thence with the line of said Survey N 56 E. 80 poles, to the Westly line of Survey N 62, thence with the same, S 45 E. 12 poles, thence N 55 E. 38 poles, thence S 79 E. 6 poles, thence N 35 E. 19 poles, thence S 75 E. 34 poles crossing Deer Creek at 2 poles thence with the line between the land of Adam Difebaugh & Morain, thence N 57 E. 128 poles, to 1st Mile tree; same course 56 poles thence S 56 E. 26 poles between the land of said Morain & Thos Robinson, thence N 57 E. 157 poles between the land of said Robinson & Thos Strain to the Palestine Road, thence with said Road, N 54 W. 50 poles, thence North between the land of John Smith & Thos Skell 36 poles to 2^d Mile tree; Thence North 80 poles with the North
