

## No. 22 Warner Road!!

4<sup>th</sup> Dec 1837

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and survey of a road commencing at Lafayette, and running to the county line on the nearest and most eligible route towards Mechanicalburg

Whereupon John Davidson, Mr James, and George Fisher Viewers and Shenny Warner Surveyor were appointed to meet at Lafayette on the 26<sup>th</sup> this inst. and proceed to view & survey said road and make return to the next Meeting of this board according to law =

1838 March 5<sup>th</sup> Report Returned favorable and Read =

1838 June 4<sup>th</sup> on application this Return id continued to next Meeting

Dec 4<sup>th</sup> No Objections being filed the following Report id ordered to be recorded, and opened according to law to wit; commencing at the North end and in the center of Bay Street in the Town of Lafayette, running from thence N 7<sup>th</sup> N. 12 poles thence N 61 N. 33 poles to the line between the land of W. Blain and Mr Minten, thence with said line N 31 N. 234 poles to the Columbus and Springfield Road, and with the same N 85 N. 31 poles to first Mile; same course 41 poles N 72 N. 94 poles N 64 N. 68 poles N 68 N. 119 poles to 2<sup>nd</sup> Mile; same course 121 poles N 57 N. 66 poles crossing Deer Creek at 78 poles, S 80 N. 44 poles, to the road leading from London to Mechanicalburg and with the same, N 50 N. 89 poles to 3<sup>rd</sup> Mile; same course, 104 poles to the Widow Stuchens House, N 60 N. 174 poles S 4 poles North of John Struckles Barn, N 64, N 42 poles to a School House 2 1/2<sup>th</sup> Mile N 40 N. 90 poles, N 6 N. 58 poles, crossing Deer Creek at 34 poles N 40 N. 172 poles to 5<sup>th</sup> Mile; same course with a line of Survey N 87 98. 24 1/2 poles N 87 N. 56 poles to 6<sup>th</sup> Mile; thence with the line between the lands of Asa Taylor and Joseph B. Kir. N 42 N. 138 poles N 19 N. 72 poles N 9 N. 60 poles N 6 N. 50 poles to 7<sup>th</sup> Mile; same course, 58 poles N 2 N. 270 poles crossing what is called the Springfield and Jefferson Road, at 100 poles 8<sup>th</sup> Mile same course 22 poles 1/2 pole East of Asa Bats House, and along his lane, N 45 N. 152 poles N 44 N. 174 poles 9<sup>th</sup> Mile same course 32 poles to Champaign County line, at a point N 60 E. 22 poles from the house lately occupied by Charles Piquen in Champaign County Total distance 9 Miles + 32 poles
