P. Foster's land thence in same course along the line between said Foster and said Dunkin to Foster's and Dunkin's corner, thence south along a strip of 4 rods left for a lane about 100 rods thence west across the lands of E. B. Chrisman to the corner of Ann Haskell's land, thence on a line between said Haskell and Chrisman to C. L. Emery's corner, thence on a line between C. L. Foster, are held and firmly bound unto the state of Ohio for the use of Madison County, in the Penal sum of Three hundred dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, jointly and severally, our heirs executors and administrators, by these presents:

Sealed with our seals and dated at London this 20th day of July 1893.

The conditions of the above obligations are such, that whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County for the establishment, construction and improvement under the statutes of Ohio relating to Two mile assessment Pikes a new road along the following described route to wit:

Commencing at a point in the Yaukeetown road about 25 yards south of the intersection of the Junk Road with the Yaukeetown Road in Rouge Township, thence in a westerly direction along the line between the lands of W^m and Luther Johnston, to Luther Johnston's Corner thence in same direction along the line between W^m Johnston and Isaac and W^m Reeves to Reeves' corner, thence in same direction along the line between said Reeves and Sarah Dunkin to another corner of Reeves, thence in same course across the lands of Sarah Dunkin to the corner of J. P. Foster's land thence in same course along the line between said Foster and said Dunkin to Foster and Dunkin's corner thence S. along a strap of 4 rods left for a lane, about 100 rods, thence west across the lands of E. B. Chrisman to the corner of Ann Haskell's land, thence in a line between said Haskell and Chrisman to C. L. Emery's corner, thence in a line between C. L. Emery and said Haskell and to the Bloomingburg Pike. A petition signed by E. B. Chrisman and 83 others land owners whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County Ohio, praying for the laying out construction and improvement, under the two mill assessment Pike laws of Ohio, of a new county road, by grading graveling bridging and culverting the same by a road along the following described route.

Commencing at a point in the Yankeetown road about 25 yards south of the intersection of the Junk Road with the Yankeetown Road in Range township, thence in a westerly direction along the line between the lands of William and Luther Johnston to Luther Johnston's corner, thence in same direction along the line between William Johnston and Isaac and William Reeves to Reeves' corner, thence in same direction along the line between said Reeves and Sarah Dunkin to another corner of Reeves thence in same course across the lands of Sarah Dunkin to the corner of J. P. Report of Viewers and Surveyor

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of
Madison County, Ohio

In compliance with your order to us hereto attached we the undersigned viewers and surveyor appointed under said order met at the Johnston school-house near the Junk Road in Range township and near the place of beginning on the 17th day of August 1893 and after having been duly sworn, as will further appear from the certificate of said oath hereto attached, we chose Thomas Pugh and James Skiles to act as chain carriers and Wm. H. Eply and Geo. W. Johnston to act as markers, who were also sworn to faithfully discharge their duties as will also appear from said certificate.

We then proceeded carefully to examine survey and layout the road described in said order as follows

Beginning at a stake in the Yunketown Road corner to the lands of Wm and Luther Johnston; thence with their line south $86\frac{1}{4}$ W. 2800 feet to a stone corner to said Luther Johnston and J. and W. Reeves, thence their line N. $86\frac{1}{4}$ W. 1158 to a stake, corner to said Wm Johnston J and W. Reeves and Sarah Dunkin thence with line of said Dunkin and Reeves S. $59^{\circ}10'$ W. 1630 feet to a stone corner said Reeves and Dunkin, thence through lands of said Dunkin N. 79 W. 2710 feet to a post near a hickory, corner to J. P. Foster;

Thence with line said Foster and Dunkin N. $86\frac{1}{2}$ W. 2935 feet to a stake. We find that in our opinion said road improvement would be of great convenience to the general public as well as the residents in its vicinity and further that it is a public necessity.

We recommend the improvement of said road as shown by said Plat, description and explanations all of which are made a part hereof.
