At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for an alteration of a County Road leading past the house of Jeremiah Cornum Esq which intersects the present Road, so called East of his house and on its course West united with the aforesaid East Road near the house of Widow Russell The proposed alteration is beginning at or near, the house of Silas Cornum, and to continue on the line between the said Cornum and Jeremiah Cornum, until it strikes the line of Albert Newton and then on the line between the said Newton and Silas Cornum until it intersects the present Road, near the School house

Ordered that by the Commissioners that Jeremiah Cornum John H. Norton and Daniel K. Bigelow Viewed and James Millikin Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Silas Cornum on the 22<sup>d</sup> April next to View Survey and Make Report according to Law to the next Meeting of this board; petitioners to pay the costs
