The conditions of the above obligations are such, that, whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Madison County, for the improvement _____ of a _____ road on the following line to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the old Springfield and Chillicothe road where the same is crossed by the line between Madison and Fayette Counties and between the lands of Henry Kline and J. W. Green, thence in a general north westerly direction following the old road between the lands of Henry Kline and J. W. Green, S. J. Paulin and Peter Dore and Mary Best, Peter Dore and Martin Moore crossing the Prairie Pike at the Hays School House, thence following the old road in still a general northwesterly direction between the lands of Melissa Allen and S. C. Shepherd, Letitia Smith and J. L. Smith, R. S. + J. A. Blaghter and John Haas and D. A. + M. A. McCluskey and David Gossard to where the road running north from Bookwalter intersects said Chillicothe + Springfield road and terminating thereat.

A petition, signed by Peter Dore, and other land holders, whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the board of commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, praying for the improvement, under the Two Mile Assessment Pike Laws of Ohio, of a road, by grading, grubbing, graveling the same along the following described route, to wit: Beginning at a point in the old Springfield and Chillicothe road where the same is crossed by the line between Madison and Fayette Counties and between the lands of Henry Klevor and J. W. Green; thence in a general northwesterly direction following the old road between the lands of Henry Klevor and J. W. Green, S. J. Paulin and Peter Dore and Mary Scott, Peter Dore and Martin Moon, crossing the Prairie Pike at the Hays school house; thence following the old road in still a general northwesterly direction between the lands of Melissa Allen and E. Viewers and
Surveyor's Report

Viewers and Surveyors Report.

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio:
 In compliance with your order to us, hereto attached
 we the undersigned Viewers and Surveyor named in
 said order, met at the beginning of the Road described
 in said order at the line between Madison and
 Fayette Counties on the 21st day of April 1908 and after
 having been duly sworn as will further appear
 from the Certificate of said oath hereto attached, we
 chose Chas. Soler and A. J. O'Neal to act as chain carriers
 and Jesse Paine to act as marker who were also sworn
 faithfully to discharge their duties as will also appear
 from said Certificate.

We then proceeded carefully to examine and survey
 the road described in said order and we hereto attach
 a plat of the lands and lots located in Madison County
 and lying within two miles of said road showing
 number of acres in each tract, the names of the
 owners thereof and the route of said road through
 said lands and lots.

The following is a correct description of the route
 and termini of said road as surveyed by us.
 Beginning at an iron pin in the line between the
 Counties of Madison and Fayette and in the line

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between the lands of H. S. Kener and J. W. Green and near the center of the old county road. Thence $N 49^{\circ} 35' W$ passing the corner of said Green and S. J. Paulin at 417 feet $80\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stone corner to H. S. Kener and Peter Don and 1758 feet to an iron pin corner to said Paulin and Mary Scott. Thence $N 64^{\circ} W$ 833 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a large boulder on the South side of said old road. Thence $N 78^{\circ} 45' W$, passing a corner of said Don and Martin Moon at 828 feet and a stone corner to said Scott and Don at 1147 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet 1465 feet to an iron pin. Thence $S 85^{\circ} W$, 881 feet to an iron pin. Thence $N 43^{\circ} 15' W$, 133 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin in the center of the Prairie Pike being 20 feet southeasterly measured with the center of said pike from a stone 20 feet distant, said stone being corner to Peter Don, S. C. Shepherd and Melissa Allen. Thence $N 43^{\circ} 2' W$ crossing the center of the D. T. & R. R. at 1233 feet 2315 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin 209 feet $S. 25\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ from a stone corner to Melissa Allen and Letitia Smith. Thence $N 43^{\circ} W$, 2944 feet to an iron pin $N 85^{\circ} 5' W$, forty one feet from a stone corner to John Haas and D. A. & M. A. Mc Chesney. Thence $N. 85^{\circ} 5' W$ 2230 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin 8.83 feet N of a stone corner to said Mc Chesney, David Gossard and R. S. & J. A. Slaughter. Thence $N 67^{\circ} 45' W$ 399 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin located in the center of said old county road and at the intersection of the center line of the Bookwater Road and being a corner to said Slaughter and Martha Vaughn and there terminating being a distance in all of 14.159 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet or 2.68 miles.

We have located said road as near the line of the old county Road as now used as we deemed practical taking into consideration in the formation of our opinion the location of farm lines, fences etc.

We find that in our opinion said road, improvement would be of great convenience to the general public as well as to the residents in its vicinity and further that it is a public necessity.

We recommend the improvement of said road as shown by the plat, descriptions and explanations made a part of this report.

We also submit herewith a list of all lands and lots located in Madison County that lie within two miles of said road as surveyed by us:

No damages were claimed or allowed.

We estimate the whole expense of said improvement at \$6056⁰⁰ classified as follows:

Grading and ditching at \$500 per mile amounting to \$1340⁰⁰

Graveling and material at \$1759.50 per mile (5240 yards at 90 cents per yard) amounting to \$4716⁰⁰

Total excluding bridges and culverts \$6056⁰⁰

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These estimates are based upon the following general specifications.

Width of Road 40 feet

Width of grade 24 feet

Crown of grade 6 inches

Gravel to be 10 feet wide and 12 inches deep, its center line coinciding with the center line of the grade.
