We, the undersigned, owners of land and taxable property within the bounds of said proposed improvement, do respectfully but earnestly remonstrate against the laying out and establishing of said free turnpike and against the appointment of commissioners therefore and beg your Honorable Body to refuse to lay out, establish, grade, gravel & improve said road for the following reasons:

1. It is not a public necessity.

2. It is not a public utility to justify its improvement, the distance from the terminus of the proposed road on the Union Pike to the terminus of the proposed road on the London & Midway Pike not being materially different from the distance between same points by way of London and Midway Pikes.

Specifications

Specifications for Improving the Drury Road, in Paint Township, by Grading, Ditching, Graveling and Culverting.  
Widths.

The road to be 50 feet wide.

Removing Obstructions - The area required for the road bed and ditches to be cleared of all obstructions, trees, bushes and brush. Said trees, bushes and brush to be removed by grubbing, if the Engineer deems necessary, and must be hauled or taken out of the limits of the road. Any tree that the Engineer shall designate shall be left standing, and if necessary must be trimmed by the contractor, so that loaded vehicles may pass under the branches. All earth, rubbish or other matters liable to obstruct the water-way or outlet of any sewer must be removed by the contractor to a depth

deemed by the Engineer sufficient for the necessary waterway. Any materials of any sort or timber in the roadway removed by the contractor to be his property.

## Grade.

The grade must be made to conform in every respect to the profile and cross section of said road; must be smooth and evenly graded, leaving no sinks or low places in which water may stand.

To be graded to the width of 13 feet on each side of the center line of the road, and crowning 6 inches to the center line of gravel.

The sides of all cuts, fills and ditches to have a slope of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  to 1; except the outside banks of ditches, which may have a slope of 1 to 1; and all earth taken from cuts to be used in making the fills.

The estimated cost of grading includes all necessary grubbing and clearing of obstructions.

## Ditches.

Side ditches must not be less than 5 feet wide on top (except in deep cuts) 2 feet wide in bottom and not less than 18 inches deep, measuring from the crown of the grade. Both banks to be smooth and evenly sloped, with angles of slopes as above specified. These ditches must be evenly graded so that no ponds or pools will be left by the road side. No sewer must be put in without a sufficient out-let, and where it is necessary the contractor must cut such out-let without extra compensation therefor.

Whenever a tile ditch comes to the road limit or crosses said road, a shoulder sink must be constructed, as the Engineer may direct. Outside banks of ditches must be given the proper slope by the use of hand tools wherever permanent fences prevent the use of plow, or wherever the Engineer may deem it necessary.

## Gravel.

The gravel must be of good quality, free from top dirt, loam, clay or sediment, and to be uniformly spread upon the grade 10 feet wide (the gravel to be on the north and west side of grade, the center line of gravel being 4 feet from center of grade, and to be 12 inches deep, the entire width). Good strong boards, 12 inches wide must be used at sides to dump the gravel against and suitable stakes or iron pins in center line of gravel. The grade must be kept smooth and free from ruts where the gravel is being dumped. Each cubic yard containing coarse gravel must be thoroughly raked with a steel or iron rake, the coarse gravel to be thrown forward and spread in the center of the gravel layer, and no stone larger than 3 three inches in diameter shall be left nearer than two feet of the edge, or 4 inches of the top of the gravel, and no stone larger than 4 inches in diameter will be regarded as gravel, and must not be used within the limits of the gravel layer. At least 800 lineal feet must be graded and completed, including side ditches before any gravel will be allowed placed thereon.

It will be the duty of the contractor to keep said grade and gravel perfectly smooth, and of the required width and depth until its final acceptance by the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio.

At time of measurement the gravel must measure full in

width and depth. No allowance will be made for shrinkage. If found deficient in width or depth the contractor must make it fill the requirements before it will be accepted or paid for.

All gravel must be subject to the inspection of the Engineer before being placed on the road.

All materials, tools, labor, forms, cement, gravel, etc., must be furnished by the contractor and cost of same is included in estimate for the work.

## Estimates.

Security - five per cent estimates will be issued if desired on completed half mile section. In no case will estimates be given on less than half mile sections which are fully completed.

## Sewers.

The contractor will furnish and put in at his own expense all sewers shown on profile each of which shall be constructed of a first class quality of cast iron culvert pipe and shall be of sizes and lengths shown on profile - the ends to be protected by walls built of concrete masonry made of clean gravel 5 parts clean sharp sand and 3 parts and Taylor's Portland Cement 1 part mixed and laid to the satisfaction of the Engineer. The walls to be of sizes shown on profile.

## Line Stones.

The contractor will furnish and set 9 stones for the purpose of marking the limit of the road way. These stones will be of quarried limestone 5 feet long  $1\frac{1}{2}$  feet square at the base and dressed 12 inches down from the top - to be 8 inches square at the top - to be set 4 feet in the ground at the beginning, terminus and half mile points of the road.

## Corner Stones.

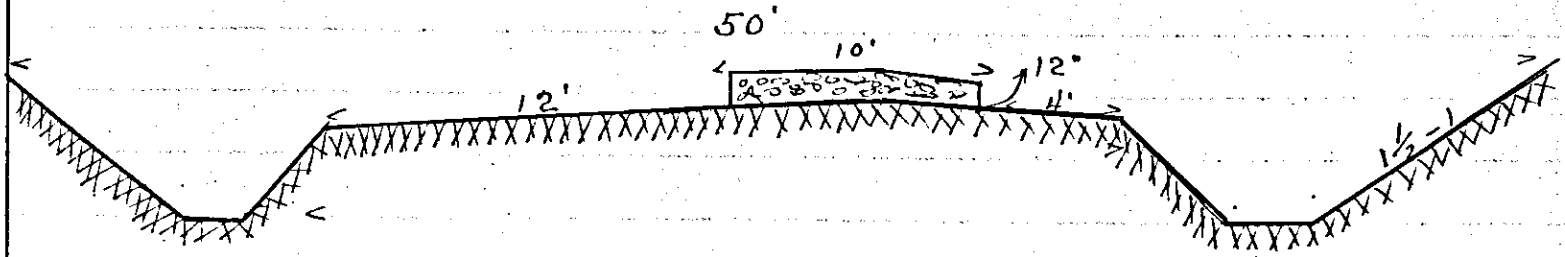
The contractor will be required to preserve all corner stones and monuments marking farm corners in such manner as the Engineer may direct.

The right is reserved by the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, and the Engineer to change or alter these specifications, or any part thereof, at any time during the progress of the work, if they deem the same to be necessary. Such change, if made will be estimated and added to or deducted from the contract price at the rate of the contract as the case may be.

Work to begin as soon as bond is given and to be fully completed by September 1<sup>st</sup> 1906.

In case of any change in plans and quantities a difference will be made in contract corresponding to rate of contract in money, estimated and allowed or deducted as the case may be.
