To the Board of Commissioners of Madison City

In compliance with your order to me directed I proceeded on the first of April to survey the alterations of the North end of the London Road - Beginning at a Stake 66 poles North East of 1<sup>st</sup> mile tree; Thence N. 16 E. 208 poles intersecting the Urbana Road at three mile tree - Ordered that the above be established 2<sup>d</sup> June 1817

Order Issued

30<sup>th</sup> March 1818

A petition was presented by Abner Chapman praying for the liberty to turn the road from Northington to Urbana through another part of his land. Ordered that James Ewing Joshua Ewing and David Clements be appointed agreeable to the 9<sup>th</sup> Section of the act for opening and regulating roads and highways

A petition was presented praying for a Road Beginning at Paint Creek where the County Road crosses it and to run from thence the nearest and best way to intersect the Urbana Road at John Blanks View appointed by James Kent, Cornelius Vandeventer & Peter Vandeventer - Surveyor McCallly Bowen - Order Issued

31<sup>st</sup> Aug 1818

At a Meeting of the Commissioners A petition was presented from the citizens of Pleasant Township praying to open the road from Washington to Columbus, also the Federal Road, also to alter the London Road from the S.E. corner M. H. Alkier's improvement so as to open on Bayler's line so far as to intersect the Old London Road Southeastward.

It is ordered that the Columbus Road be opened nearly on the same ground also the Federal Road; and Viewers appointed on the London Road; Viewers Albert Ogden, John Reade, and William Wood; Surveyor John Smith to meet 2<sup>d</sup> Monday Sept at M. H. Alkier

Order Issued 3<sup>rd</sup> Sept 1818

9<sup>th</sup> Nov 1818 Received the following Report

September 14<sup>th</sup> 1818

Gentlemen according to your appointment we met at the House of Michael H. Alkier on the London Road and after being duly sworn we proceed to view the ground on which you were petitioned for an alteration on the aforesaid Road, and we after much deliberation have to state to you how as we concluded that the alteration petitioned for on said Road will much conduce to the benefit of the public; we are yours with respect
