

Finley Road Improvement
June 5, 1889.

This day the Board of Commissioners of Meadison County, O. met in regular session pursuant to notice of yesterday, Members present W. E. Seale, A. C. Will & J. P. Brown.

In the Matter of Finley Road Improvement.

The report of the viewers heretofore appointed, having been made as required by law, & said report being in favor of said improvement & showing that there is a public necessity therefor & the board being satisfied by a comparison & conflict of the petitions for said improvement & land holders taxable therefor as reported by the viewers & other evidence that a majority of land owners whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the same have signed the petitions asking for said improvement (said majority being 39) that public utility require it & that the proceedings had are in conformity to law.

The Board therefore order the reports & plat in said matter to be duly recorded & filed & said improvement to be made in the following manner to wit:

1. That the road ~~be~~ be opened to a width of 25 ft. on each side of its center line
 2. That the road be cleared of all obstructions to a width of 20 ft on each side its center line by grubbing all trees & stumps from cuts & side ditches & by cutting them off even with the ground in fills.
 3. That the road bed must be smoothly & evenly graded to a width of 12 feet on each side of, & crowning 6 inches to its center line, with side slopes of $1\frac{1}{2}$ horizontal to one vertical, leaving a 2 foot berm at base of all fills with center dirt grade & horizontal lines never making a greater angle than 1 in 20 .
 4. That the side ditches be made not less than 2 ft. wide in the bottom & that the bottom be not less than 2 ft. below the center dirt grade line of the road, with inside slopes of one & a half to one & outside slopes of one to one, unobstructed & continuous, leaving no ponds nor pools in side ditches, with complete drainage to all culverts.
 5. That all culverts must be made of good sound white or bur oak material, timber hewn on three sides, with parallel beddings, top logs 24 ft. long & each log below 2 ft. longer than the one above it, side walls laid upon three sub sills, 10 inches diameter, the tops of which must be sunk well below the bottom of the water way, faced & shouldered above to receive fish logs & each log above battered $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches from waterway, upon the log below. The plank must be of the best shifty timber, 22 ft. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ by 6 to 8 inches & spiked to 9 stringers, with round bent spikes & top of culverts when completed must stand within 4 inches of the top of gravel grade.
- When locations & drainage warrant, best second class sewer pipe may be used. All arch & round must be of capacity & dimensions sufficient for the place where employed.

- 6. When the road bed as above prepared, must be spread, uniformly a layer of clean gravel, free from dirt, loam or fine sand, 10 ft. wide ^{and} 8 ft. deep, with center line of gravel, every where 4 ft. to the right of dirt track to the left, raking all coarse gravel into the bottom of the gravel layer, ^{and} leaving no stone that cannot be passed through a 2 1/2 inch ring nearer than 4 inches of the top of the gravel grade, being 1985 1/2 cubic yards per mile.
- 7. That the grubbing, clearing, grading, ditching ^{and} culverting must be completed in parcels of not less than 80 rods as above to the acceptance of the Engineer before the grading of any such parcel is commenced.
- 8. Each section of one half mile when completed to the acceptance of the Engineer ^{and} Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, will be received ^{and} paid for in full.

The Board therefore appoints Jas. Arnett as Engineer to take charge of said improvement to advertise ^{and} sell the same according to law, ^{and} require said work to be done by the 1st day of December 1889. Payment for said work will be made in cash, but no payment will be made until after the sale of the Bonds for said improvement ^{and} for the purpose of raising money necessary to pay for said improvement.

It is ordered that bonds of the County be issued of equal amounts due at intervals of six months for the period of said bonds bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually ^{and} the proper assessment placed upon the road duplicate as provided in sections 4846, Rev. Statutes of Ohio.

The Board find that the following lands will be benefited by said improvement ^{and} should be assessed to pay taxes thereon:
