A petition signed by Charles Foster and other land holders, whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, praying for the improvement, under the Two Mile Assessment Bill Law of Ohio, of a road by straightening, grading, graveling, bridging and culverting the same along the following described route: commencing at the Chrisman School House; thence S. following the Foster Township Road to the Federal Road along the present route of said Foster Township Road as near as practical, being about one and one-half miles in length.

A good and sufficient bond signed by Charles Foster, Murtel Foster and James Pedman in the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) conditioned according to law, has also been filed with said board.

Thereupon, said board appointed A. P. O'Neil, James Witherow and O. P. Jones, three disinterested free holders of the county, as viewers, and N. B. McCallerty as surveyor, and directed them to meet at the beginning of said proposed road as described in the petition on the 29th day of October, 1907, at 10 o'clock A.M., and after being duly sworn, to take to their assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers, and one marker, and proceed to view, examine, layout, or straighten said road as in their opinion public utility and convenience require, to assess and determine the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the road is proposed to be laid out, straightened or improved; and to do such

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other things in the premises as are required of them by law, and to make report of their proceedings in writing, to this board at its regular session, Thursday, December 5, 1907.

The county auditor is requested to give notice, as required by law in such case.

On the question of the adoption of the foregoing orders and findings relating to said proposed road improvement, the roll being called, J. W. Bowers, W. P. Sherwin, and E. Roberts voted "Ays."

Lohr, marker of a 2 mile assessment strike petitioned for by Chas. Foster et al., commencing in the E. B. Chrisman's place 25 feet south of the south east corner of the Chrisman School lot and extending to the Federal road in Bangs Township, Madison County, Ohio, and were by me each duly sworn to discharge faithfully and according to law the duties of their several appointments.

Viewers and Surveyors Report.

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison Co., Ohio:

In compliance with your order to us hereto attached, we, the undersigned Viewers and Surveyors met at the point described in said order at the beginning of the proposed improvement therein named, at 10 o'clock, A.M., on the 29th day of October, 1907, and after being duly sworn as will further appear from the certificate of said order hereto attached, we chose Jas. Holdsberry and Ralph Asher to act as chain carriers and Chas. Lohr to act as marker, who were also duly sworn faithfully to discharge their duties as will also appear from said certificate.

We then proceeded carefully to examine survey and lay out the road described in said order and we have hereto attached a plat of the lands and lots lying within 2 miles of said road, showing the number of acres in each tract, the names of the owners thereof and the route of said road through said lands and lots and other descriptions and explanations relating to said road as surveyed and laid out by us.

The following is a description of said road as we located the same. Beginning at an iron pin at an angle of the E. B. Chrisman road 25 feet south from the south east corner of the Chrisman School lot; thence E. 82 feet to a stake in the center of the Foster Township road stake being 264 feet south $0^{\circ} 15' 20''$ from

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a point in the center of said Christiana pike, said point being the northerly terminus of said Foster Township road; Thence following the center of said Township road S. 0° 15' W. passing the corner of Nathan and Earl M. Hillispio and Harry Pather at 1229 feet, the corner of said Pather and Elias Foster at 3263 feet + 818 feet to a stake; Thence S. 5° 10' W. passing the corner of Elias Foster and Eliza M. Foster at 389 feet to an iron pin in the center of the Federal road corner to said Eliza M. Foster and Sarah Dunklin being a distance in all of 8075 feet or 1.529 miles.

We find that in our opinion said road improvement would be of great convenience to the general public as well as to the residents in its vicinity, and further that it is a public necessity.

We recommend the improvement of said road as shown by said plat, descriptions and explanations all of which are made a part hereof and also that the 264 feet of the Foster Township road extending from the Christiana pike to the first angle as shown in the above description be vacated and abandoned.

We also submit herewith list of all lands lots lying within 2 miles of said road.

No compensation and damages were claimed or allowed the the road as granted by us occupying the premises formerly appropriated for the Foster Road.

We estimate the whole expense of said improvement at \$2409.70 classified as follows:-

Grading and ditching 1.529 miles @ \$400.00 per mile	\$ 611 60
Gravel and material 1.529 miles @ 1176.00 per mile	\$1798 10
Total excluding bridges and culverts	\$ 2409 70

These estimates are based upon the following general specifications:

- Width of road 40 feet
- " " grade 24 " "
- " " kerney " 8 inches
- " " width " gravel 10 feet
- " " depth " " 12 inches

The gravel to be placed upon the center of the grade which shall crown 8 inches to its center line.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

In the matter of the Redman Road Improvement ordered, etc.

The report of the viewers heretofore appointed having been made as required by law, and said report being in favor of said improvement and showing that there is public necessity therefor, and the board being satisfied by a comparison and consult. of the petitioners for said improvement, and land owners taxable therefor, as reported by the viewers, that a majority of land owners whose lands would be assessed for the expense of the same, having signed the petition asking for said improvement, that public utility requires it, and that the proceedings heretofore had were in conformity to law.

The board, therefore, order the reports and plat in said matter to be duly recorded, and filed and said improvement be made in the following manner to-wit:-

The road to be widened to a width of 40 feet, 20 feet on each side of the center line.

The grade to be 24 feet wide crowning 8 inches to the center line of the gravel. The gravel to be placed on the east side of the grade 10 feet wide and 12 inches deep, sides and center.

Specifications

Specifications for improving the Foster road in Range Township, Madison County, Ohio, by Grading, ditching, Graveling, and Culverting.

(1) Width.

The road to be Forty (40) feet wide throughout its entire length.

(2) Removing Obstructions.

The entire area of the road to the full width of Forty (40) feet must be cleared of all obstructions, such as trees, stumps, bushes, brush or large stones. All trees and bushes to be grubbed and must be buried or taken out of the road limits. Stones must be either removed from the road or buried deep enough so as not to obstruct the road in any way.

Any tree that the Engineer may designate shall be left standing and if necessary the contractor must trim them so that loaded vehicles may pass under the branches.

All earth, rubbish or other matter liable to obstruct the waterway or outlet of any sewer or culvert must be removed by the contractor to a depth deemed by the Engineer sufficient for the necessary waterway.

All materials of any sort such as timber or stone in the road limits and removed by the contractor, becomes his property.

(3) Grade.

The grade must be made to conform in every respect to the profile and cross section, must be smooth and even leaving no rills or low places in which water may stand.

The grade shall have a width of Twelve (12) feet on each side of the center line of the road and crown eight (8) inches there to.

The sides of all cuts, fills and ditches to have a slope of $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 except where otherwise designated by the Engineer, and all earth taken from the cuts to be used in making the fills.

The estimated cost of grading includes necessary grubbing and removing obstructions.

(4) Ditches.

On each side of the road bed there shall be cut a ditch at least Five (5) feet wide on top (except in deep cuts) and two (2) feet wide on bottom and in no place less than Twenty (20) inches deep measuring from the crown of the grade.

The ditch must be smooth and have the required slope of $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 on the side next to the road-bed and the outside of the ditch shall have a gentle slope outward.

In low ground where there is not sufficient earth to make the grade the required height the ditches must not be excavated below a uniform grade line but dirt must be obtained from the ditches on the higher ground.

The ditches when completed must have an even grade in the bottom so that the water will flow uninterruptedly to the culverts.

Whenever a tile ditch comes up to the road limit or crosses the road a border curb must be constructed as Engineer may direct.

Outside banks of ditches must be given the proper slope by the use of hand tools wherever permanent fences prevent the use of a plow or wherever the Engineer may deem it necessary.

(5) Sewers.

The Contractor shall furnish and put in at his own expense all sewers shown on the profile, each of which shall be constructed of a first class quality of cast iron culvert pipe (heavy weight) and shall be of rigid and length shown on the profile. The ends to be protected by walls built of concrete made of clean gravel $4\frac{1}{2}$ parts, clean sharp sand $2\frac{1}{2}$ part and Saylor's Portland Cement 1 part, mixed and laid to the satisfaction of the Engineer. "For dimensions see profile."

No sewer must be put in without a sufficient outlet and where necessary the Contractor must construct said outlet without extra compensation therefore.

(6) Gravel.

The gravel shall be uniformly spread upon the center of the grade as above prepared and shall be Ten (10) feet wide and Twelve (12) inches deep sides and center. Good string boards 12 inches wide must be used at sides to dump the gravel against and suitable stakes or iron pins used in the center line of the gravel.

(7) Maintenance of Grade and Gravel.

The grade must be kept smooth and free from ruts where the gravel is being dumped and all coarse gravel must be thoroughly raked with a steel or iron rake. The coarse gravel to be thrown forward and spread in the center of the gravel layer and no stone larger than 3 inches in diameter shall be left nearer than 2 feet of the edge or 4 inches of the top of the gravel and no stone larger than 4 inches in diameter will be regarded as gravel and must not be used within the limits of the gravel layer. At least One Thousand (1000) lineal feet of grade must be completed including side ditches and sewers before any gravel will be allowed placed thereon and the Contractor must obtain the written consent of the Engineer before he places any gravel on the road. All gravel must be subject to inspection by the Engineer before being placed on the road. The Contractor shall keep the grade smooth and free from ruts and washouts, and the gravel smooth and uniform as to alignment and depth until final acceptance by the Commissioners of Madison Co. O.

At times of measurement the gravel must be measured full width and depth as no allowance will be made for shrinkage. If found deficient in measurement the Contractor must make up the deficiency before any estimates will be given.

(8) Lime Stones.

The Contractor will furnish and set stones for the purpose of

marking the limit of the road. These shall be of quarried limestone Five (5) feet long, Four (4) inches square at the base Eight (8) inches square at the top to be dressed Twelve (12) inches down from the top and shall be set Four (4) feet in the ground at points designated by the Engineer.

(9) Corner Stones.

The Contractor will be required to preserve all corner stones and monuments of whatever kind marking farm corners in such manner as directed by the Engineer. Said Contractor will be held responsible for the removal or destruction of any such monuments.

(10) Estimates.

75% of estimates will be issued, if desired on completed 1/2 mile sections and in no case will estimates be issued on less than 1/2 mile sections, which are fully completed. Grading, sewer and graveling.

(11) Change in Specifications.

The right is reserved by the Board of County Commissioners of said County and the County Surveyor to change or alter these specifications or any part thereof either in character or quantity at any time during the progress of the work if they deem the same to be necessary. Such changes made however will be estimated and added or deducted from the contract price at the rate of the contract price as the case may be, but such changes will not be binding upon the Contractor until he has had notice of the same in writing, signed by the Engineer and approved by the Commissioners. Work to begin and to be fully completed by

The Commissioners reserve the right to reject all bids.
