To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Madison County,
We, the undersigned, residents Land Owners of Madison County, Ohio,
whose lands are situated within two miles of the contemplated
improvement, herein described, and whose lands will be
assessed for the expense of said improvement, respectfully pe-
tition your board according to the provisions of the laws of Ohio,
for the improvement, By Grading, Graveling, Bridging and
Culverting of the Road, leading from the Taylor pike in
Mouroe Township to the Wilson pike in said Township. Beginning
at an iron rod in the center of the Taylor pike and corner
John Kreamer and Solomon Paugh a forked burr oak 2 1/2
feet in diameter bears S. 75° W. 29 1/2 feet from said iron rod:
thence upon the line between the lands of Kreamer and Paugh,
Burrell and Allen Laff, pass stone corner of Paugh and
Burrell 13.87 chains, (Chain 100 feet) stone corner of Burrell and
Laff 18.66 chains, south 55° 30' W. to a stone at 21.91 chains
corner of Kreamer, Laff, Grewell and Lafayette Wilson, thence
on a line between the lands of Wilson, Grewell and Owen
Harbage, pass stone corner of Grewell and Harbage at 41.46
chains South 55° 30' West to stone at 48.51 chains corner of Wilson
and Harbage; thence on line of S. Wilson and Harbage passing
center of old County road at 51.03 chains W. 78° 45' to a stone at
58.13 chains. Said stone is centrally between two burr oaks
12 1/2 feet apart: thence crossing Little Darby Creek at 2.80 chains
W. 89° 30' West to stone at 61.28 chains corner of Lafayette and
Sarah Wilson and Owen Harbage; thence on line of Sarah Wilson
and Owen Harbage, South 72° 31' West to stone in center of
Wilson pike at 75.54 chains; said stone is corner of Wilson,
Harbage and A. G. Pratt. A white oak 20 inches in diameter

Know all Men by These Presents.

That we, E. C. Grewell, Allen Laff, and Geo. Grewell are held and firmly bound, unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Madison County, in the penal sum of Two Hundred Dollars for the true and faithful payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, jointly and severally our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated at London, Ohio, this day of April 1896.

The condition of the above obligations are such, that whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Madison County, for the improvement of a road on the following line, to wit:

Beginning at an iron rod in the center of the Taylor Pike and corner John Kreamer and Solomon Paugh, a forked burr oak $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet in diameter bears 75° W. $29\frac{1}{2}$ feet from said iron rod, thence upon the line between the lands of Kreamer and Paugh, Burrell^{and} Allen Laff, pass stone corner of Paugh and Burrell 13.87 chains (Chain 100 feet) stone corner Burrell^{and} Laff, 18.66 chains, South $55^{\circ} 30'$ W. to a stone at 21.91 chains, corner of Kreamer Laff, Grewell^{and} Lafayette Wilson; Thence on a line between the lands of Wilson, Grewell^{and} Owen Harbage, pass stone corner Grewell and Harbage at 41.46 chains south $55^{\circ} 30'$ West to stone at 48.51 chains, corner of Wilson and Harbage; Thence on line of S. Wilson^{and} Harbage passing center of old county road at 51.03 chains W. $78^{\circ} 45'$ W. to a stone at 58.13 chains, said stone is centrally between two burr oaks $12\frac{1}{2}$ feet apart; thence crossing Little Darby Creek at 2.80 chains N. $89^{\circ} 30'$ W. to a stone at 61.28 chains, corner Lafayette and Sarah Wilson and Owen Harbage;

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Thence on a line of Sarah Wilson and Owen Harbage, South 72° 31' W. to stone in center of Wilson pike at 75.54 chains, said stone is corner of Wilson, Harbage and A. A petition having been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, asking for the improvement under and in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes of Ohio, relating to two mile assessment Pikes by grading, graveling, bridging and culverting of the Road, leading from the Taylor Pike in Monroe Township to the Wilson Pike in said township, Beginning at an iron rod in the center of the Taylor Pike and corner of John Kreamer & Solomon Paugh, a forked burr oak 2 1/2 feet in diameter bears south 75° W. 29 1/2 feet from said iron rod; thence upon the line between the lands of Kreamer and Paugh, Burrell and Allen Laff pass stone corner of Paugh and Burrell 13.87 chains. A Petition signed by E. C. Grewell and seventy-one land holders whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, praying for the improvement under the two mile assessment pike laws of Ohio, of a road by grading, graveling, bridging and culverting the same along the following described route:

Beginning at an iron rod in the center of the Taylor pike and corner John Kreamer and Solomon Paugh; a forked burr-oak 2 1/2 feet in diameter, bears S. 25° W. 29 1/2 feet from said iron rod; thence upon the line between the lands of Kreamer and Paugh, Burrell and Allen Laff, pass stone corner of Paugh and Burrell 13.87 chains (chains 100 feet) stone corner Burrell and Laff 18.66 chains, south 55° 30' W. to a stone at 21.91 chains, corner of Kreamer, Laff, Grewell and Lafayette Wilson; thence on a line between the lands of Wilson, Grewell and Owen Harbage, pass stone corner of Grewell and Harbage at 41.46 chains corner Wilson and Harbage; thence on a line of S. Report of Viewers and Surveyor.

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio:
In compliance with your order to us, hereto attached, we, the undersigned Viewers and Surveyor, named in said order, met at the residence of E. C. Grewell, on the 30th day of April, 1896 and after having been duly sworn as will further appear from the certificate of said oath, hereto attached, we chose S. P. Wilson and Allen Laff to act as chain carriers, and E. C. Grewell and James Thacker to act as markers, who were also sworn faithfully to discharge their duties as will also appear from said certificate. We then proceeded carefully to examine, survey and lay out the road described in said order along the following route.

Beginning at an iron rod in the center of the Taylor pike corner to land of John Kreamer and Solomon Paugh. Thence S. 56° 10' W. (passing corner said Paugh and Thomas Burrell at 1389 feet, corner of said Burrell and Allen Laff at 1867 feet, corner of said Laff and E. C. Grewell at 2693 feet, corner said Kreamer and Isaac Alder, Trustee, at 2693 feet and corner of said Grewell and Owen Harbage at 4150 feet) 4854 feet to a point. Thence N. 75° 5' W. 763 feet to a stake between two burr-oak stumps. Thence N. 88 1/2° W. 518 feet to a stone corner to said Alder, and Sarah A. Wilson, (crossing Little Darby creek at 167 feet). Thence S. 73 1/4° W. 1435 feet to a stone in the center of the Wilson and Wingate pike corner to said Sarah A. Wilson,

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Owen Harbage, A. G. Pratt, and H. K. Wilson, and terminating thereat. Total length 7570 feet or 1.43 miles.

We file, herewith a plat of the lands and lots lying within 2 miles of said road, showing the number of acres in each lot the names of the owners thereof and the route of said road through said lands and lots and explanations relating to said road as surveyed and laid out by us.

We also submit herewith a list of all lands and lots lying within two miles of said road as surveyed, showing the number of acres, the survey numbers and the names of the owners of each tract.

We find that in our opinion, said road improvement would be of great convenience to the general public as well as to the residents in its vicinity and further that it is a public necessity.

We recommend the improvement of said road as shown by said plat and explanations all of which are made a part hereof.

We estimate the whole expense of said improvement at \$1581.⁵⁰/₁₀₀ classified as follows:

Grading and ditching at \$400. ⁰⁰ per mile	Amounting to	\$572.00
Graveling and material at \$705. ⁰⁰ per mile (3365 cu. yds. at 30¢ per yard)	Amounting to	1009.50
Total		\$1581.50

These estimates are based on the following general specifications. The road bed and the grade to be made 22 feet wide. The culverts to be of sewer pipe. The gravel to be placed upon center of grade 12 feet wide and 12 inches deep sides and center. The grade to crown 12 inches to the center line.

Specifications

1. Width - The road to be opened to the width of 40 feet, (20 feet on each side of the center line thereof.)
2. Removing obstructions - The contractor must clear the road of all obstructions to the width of 36 feet (18 feet on each side of the center line) All trees and stumps within the area required for the road bed and ditches shall be removed by grubbing, except in fills of 1 foot or more where they may be cut off level with the natural surface of the ground; and all earth, rubbish or other matter liable to obstruct the water way of any sewer or culvert must be removed by the contractor to a depth deemed by the Engineer sufficient for the necessary waterway or outlet.
3. Corner Stones - Contractors are required to preserve all monuments and corners to lands found in the road bed and will be held responsible if the same are destroyed or lost.
4. Grade - To conform to the profile and cross sections filed herewith. To be smooth and evenly graded, leaving no sinks or low places in the surface thereof and to a width of 11 feet on each side of the center line of the road, crowning 6 inches to the center line thereof and leaving 2 feet berm of unbroken earth at base of all fills.
The sides of all cuts, fills and ditches to have a slope of 1 to 1 or 45°. Except where the fill is over 3 feet where the slope is to be 1 1/2 to 1 or 33° 42'. All dirt moved in the cutting of hills to be used in the grades.
5. Ditches - Side ditches must not be in any case less than 5 on top, 2 feet wide in the bottom, nor less than 2 feet below the center line of the grade. Must have both banks sloped 1 to 1. The bottom of these ditches must be smooth and evenly graded leaving no ponds or pools by the road side.
The road must be thoroughly drained.
If it is deemed necessary by the Engineer the contractor must, without extra compensation cut outlets for any or all sewers that cross the road. These outlet ditches to be 1 foot wide in the bottom, with banks sloped 1 to 1. and at each point in the

road where a tile ditch crosses, the contractor must construct a sink over the same in accordance with the instructions of the Engineer.

6. Gravel. To be of good quality, entirely free from top dirt, loam, clay or sediment and to be uniformly spread upon center of grade 12 feet wide (6 feet on each side of center line), and 12 inches deep sides and center.

Each cubic yard containing large stones or coarse gravel to be thoroughly raked with a steel or iron rake, the rakings to be thrown forward and spread in the center of the road bed; and no stone larger than $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter shall be left nearer than 2 feet of the edge or nearer than 4 inches of the top of the gravel. No stone larger than 4 inches in diameter will be regarded as gravel and must not be placed within the limits of the road. At least 80 rods of the road must be graded and accepted by the Engineer before any gravel will be allowed placed thereon, and it shall be the duty of the contractor to keep said grade perfectly smooth and to keep the gravel in the same condition until the final acceptance of the road by the Board of Commissioners of Madison County.

At measurement time the gravel must measure full in width and depth and if found lacking the contractor shall complete it as no allowance whatever will be made for shrinkage.

7. All material to be furnished by the contractor.

8. The right is reserved by the Commissioners and Engineer to change these specifications in any manner they may see fit, at any time during the progress of the work, and the contractor shall receive extra compensation at the rate of his contract if the labor required of him be increased; or a reduction will be made at the same rate if the labor required of him be reduced.

9. Seventy five per cent estimates will be issued on completed sections.

10. Contractor to furnish on the ground and put in all sewer pipe shown on the profile and this is to be done according to instructions of the Engineer and without any extra compensation therefor.

11. No part of said work is to be sublet without consent of the Commissioners and Engineer.

12. Specifications will be rigidly enforced in every detail and particular.

13. To be fully completed on or before Nov. 1st 1896.
