Road Petition to Construct or Improve.

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio.

The undersigned petitioners, being at least fifty one per cent. of the land or lot owners, residents of said county, who would be specially taxed or assessed for the improvement, hereby petition you for the improvement of a public road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at the junction of the Cemetery Pike, T.H.No. 34, with the Plain City and Georgesville Road, C.H. No. 7, commonly known as the East Pike, near the residence of L.G.Huff; thence following the line of said Cemetery Pike in a north easterly direction to its junction with the Plain City-Dublin Road, I.C.H. No. 242 near the school house in sub district No. 1, Darby Township; a distance of approximately (1.75) one and seventy five hundredths miles.

Your petitioners ask that the improvement shall consist of grading, draining and resurfacing with crushed stone, using approximately thirteen hundred tons of stone to the mile; also that the compensation, damages, cost and expenses of said improvement be apportioned in accordance with method No. 1 under Section 6919 of the General Code of Ohio.

It is hereby agreed by the undersigned County Commissioners and County Surveyor of Madison County, Ohio, that the Specifications and Estimate for the construction of the Cemetery Road, as submitted by said County Surveyor shall be changed and made to read as follows:

SPECIFICATIONS.

SUBGRADE.

The gravel or stone now on the road shall be scarified or loosened up and spread to a width of ten feet to form a bed on which the new road metal shall be placed.

As nearly all of the stone or gravel now on the road shall be used for a bed for the new material and shall be shaped to give the finished road the crown as shown on the drawings.

Low places along the sides shall be filled up and leveled so as to make smooth and uniform berms. Dirt for this purpose may be taken from the ditches on the side.

SIZES OF MATERIAL.

Material passing through a 1 1/2 inch opening and by laboratory test containing not more than 5% of material that will pass a 1/4 inch opening and not more than 75% of Materials that will pass or be retained on a 3/4 inch opening.

LOOSE STONE COURSE.

After the roadbed has been prepared and accepted by the engineer, a layer of broken stone of the approved size and quality shall be spread evenly over it to the required width and depth. Heavy boards shall be firmly staked at the sides of the stone layer for the purpose of keeping the alignment and depth.

Width of stone layer - 10 feet; Length, including length of bridges 8990 feet; Culverts, new, one (1)

Depth of stone layer - 5 1/2 inches, sides and center; width of grade, at approaches to Darby Creek bridge, both sides, 20 feet.

Contractors and others interested will take notice that the plans, specifications and estimates of the construction of the Cemetery Road Improvement are on file in the office of the County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, and that sealed proposals will be received at the office of the County Commissioners for the building and construction of said road according to the said plans, and specifications, until the 13th day of December, 1916, at 12 o'clock, A.M., on which date said bids will be opened.

The work consists of 1488 cubic yards of crushed stone (placed on road.)

Reshaping grade-

36 feet of 12 inch solid round C.I. pipe (laid)

Width of stone layer 10 feet.

Length including length of bridges, 8990 feet.

Depth of stone layer 5 1/2 inches, sides and center.

Width of grade at approaches to Darby Creek bridge, both sides, 20 feet.

Each bid shall contain the name of every person interested in the same and shall be accompanied by a certified check equal to the sum of 5% on the amount of the bid to guarantee that if said bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into, and the performance of it properly secured, as required by law and the Commissioners.
