Viewers and Surveyors Report.

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio.

In compliance with your order to us, hereto attached, we, the undersigned viewers and surveyor met at the point described in said order at the beginning of the proposed improvement, therein named, at 10 o'clock A.M. on the 2nd day of June 1909, and after being duly sworn as will further appear from the certificate of said oath hereto attached, we chose Jesse Paine and A. J. O'Neal to act as chain carriers and Henry Smith as marker, who were also duly sworn to faithfully discharge their duties as will also appear from certificate of said oath hereto attached.

We then proceeded carefully to examine, survey and lay out the road described in said order, and we have hereto attached a plat of the lands and lots lying within 2 miles of said road, showing the number of acres in each tract, the names of the owners, thereof and the route of said road through said lands and lots and other descriptions and explanations relating to said road as surveyed and laid out by us.

The following is a description of said road as we located the same.

Beginning at an iron pin (iron tooth) driven in the north edge of the gravel in Patrick improved road, near the corner of the lands of W.P. Patrick and the lands of C.W. & Flora Guy; thence, crossing line between Monroe and Pike townships at 1042 feet, branch at 1077 feet, $N 19^{\circ} - 45' E$, 3096 feet to a stone, corner of W.P. Patrick's land and the lands of H.C. Guy; thence passing first mile stake at 2184 feet, $N 19^{\circ} - 55' E$, 3062 feet to a stake at an angle in road; said stake is $S 19^{\circ} - 31' W$. from a stone, $N.W.$ corner of the lands of C.W. & Flora Guy; thence, $N 9^{\circ} - 15' W$, passing corner of C.W. & Flora Guy and W^c Clitock Heirs at 74 feet, corner of said Heirs and corner of John S. & Martha A. Baker at 151 feet, corner of said Baker and W^c Guy at 413 feet, the $S.W.$ corner of a cemetery at 624 feet and the $N.W.$ corner of said cemetery at 964 feet, 1145 feet to a stake at an angle of road; thence $N 2^{\circ} - 23' W$, crossing the south edge of an iron bridge at 693 feet and the north edge 139 $\frac{3}{10}$ feet 936 $\frac{3}{10}$ feet to an iron pin (iron tooth) in the center of the Silverpool and Mechanicsburg pike, and there terminating a distance in all of 1.56 miles or 8239 $\frac{3}{10}$ ft.

A cotton wood tree bears $N 73^{\circ} - 30' E$, 50 $\frac{3}{10}$ ft. from said last named iron pin.

We find that in our opinion said road improvement would be of great convenience to the general public as well as to the residents in its vicinity and further that it is a public necessity.

We recommend the improvement of said road as shown by said plat, descriptions and explanation all of which are made a part hereof.

We also submit herewith a list of all lands and lots lying within 2 miles of said road.

No compensation or damage were claimed or allowed, the road as granted by us occupying the line of an old established road.

We estimate the whole expense of said improvement at \$3519 $\frac{36}{100}$ classified as follows:

Grading and ditching	1.56 miles @ \$300 ⁰⁰	\$468.00
Graveling and materials	1.56 " @ \$1956 ⁰⁰	3051.68
Total, excluding bridge elements		\$3519.68
