RESOLUTION TO IMPROVE 5-12-41

The County Commissioners of Madison County, met in regular session on the 12th day of May, 1941, at the offices of said Madison County Commissioners with the following members present:

Robert Armstrong; Cola Mink; Rodney Plymell

Mr. Mink moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, contemplates improving and straightening a certain road a description thereof being hereinafter accurately set out, and

WHEREAS, this said board is of the opinion that the hereinafter mentioned improvements will be advantageous to the public convenience and welfare; now, therefore, be it resolved:

Section 1. That a road commonly known as the High Free Pike in Madison County, Ohio, running eastward from a road commonly known as the East Pike in said Madison County to the Madison County Franklin County line shall be improved by draining, grading and straightening, said straightening of the High Free Pike shall be in accordance with the plat and specifications attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. That the Commissioners shall view the aforementioned location of the improvements on the 16th day of May, 1941 and a final hearing will be held therefore on the 2nd day of June, 1941.

Section 3. That the aforementioned Resolution shall be published according to law, thereby giving all interested parties notice of view and hearing.

Mr. Plymell seconded the Resolution and on the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows:

RESOLUTION 8-25-41

The County Commissioners of Madison County, met in regular session on the 25th day of August, 1941 at the offices of said Madison County Commissioners with the following members present:

Robert Armstrong. Rodney Plynell

Mr. Plynell moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, is of the opinion that the proposed improvement specifically set out and referred to in Resolution 8-12-41, duly passed by said board of County Commissioners at the regular meeting held on May 12, 1941, will serve the public convenience and welfare and will be of great benefit thereto; now, therefore, be it resolved:

Section 1. That the County Surveyor make an accurate survey and plat of the improvement referred to in aforesaid Resolution 8-12-41, describing the center line therein and right of way lines thereof; and that, at the time of making the survey the Surveyor shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between the termini and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed improvement may be discernible to property owners and other interested persons; and, further, that the said Surveyor furnish an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which he believes will be necessary to be taken in the event the proposed improvement be made, together with the name of each owner.

Section 2. That the Surveyor make a report, in writing, to the County Commissioners before the 3 day of Sept., 1941 wherein he shall set forth his opinion either for or against the improvement; said report shall also be accompanied by said plat and detailed and accurate descriptions and filed with the County Commissioners.

Section 3. That the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners shall certify a true and accurate copy of the Resolution to the Surveyor of Madison County, Ohio

E- PROSECUTOR'S LETTER ABOUT VACATING OLD ROAD

Dear Sir:

Several weeks ago the Nisslehicken Camp Company consulted me in regard to taking necessary steps to vacate a part of the right-of-way which has been fenced in by the aforesaid corporation and on which there have been buildings erected.

In view of the fact that the proposed new right-of-way has not been occupied by the county nor has any construction started preparatory thereto I advised the aforesaid corporation that I would not approve of such a move. However, after talking to the Commissioners and the County Surveyor I suggested that an agreement might be entered into whereby the old right-of-way would be vacated when the county took possession of the new right-of way.

I am enclosing two copies of the agreement which was written by Mr. Robert Draper, Attorney for the Nisslehicken Camp Company and would appreciate it if you would present it to the Commissioners for their approval or rejection. If there is any further information that they require I will be very glad to appear before them at their convenience.

P-AGREEMENT TO VACATE

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 11 day of October, 1943, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, and the Nisslehicken Camp Company, a corporation, witnesseth:-

WHEREAS, for a period of 23 years the corporation herein named has owned a piece of ground upon which has been built cottages, and

WHEREAS, said corporation has fenced in a strip of ground which was included in the right-of-way of a certain county road located in the Township of Jefferson, Madison County, Ohio, and bounding said corporation line on the north thereof, said strip of land being approximately 40 poles long and 13 feet wide, ending at Big Darby Creek, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has obtained a new right-of-way to the north of the present right-of-way and it is their intent to eventually relocate said road,

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the parties hereto as follows:

Said Board of County Commissioners, County Engineer and County Prosecutor, by resolution duly adopted, hereby agree with the corporation herein that as soon as said new right-of-way is perfected and said relocation of said road is commenced, they will take the necessary steps and procedure to vacate that part of the present right-of-way which has been fenced in by said corporation and on which there have been erected, said strip of right-of-way being approximately 40 poles long beginning at the

01.30 acre tract belonging to Fannie Reeb, and running in a general westwardly direction therefrom to Big Darby Creek, and being approximately 13 feet wide.


