

Finched Road.

1843 March 6th

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and Survey of a Road as follows: Beginning in Darby Township on the Landon Road at the North-easterly corner of Elijah Peck's land which is the upper back corner to Charles Symons Survey No 1479 and running from thence S 37 E on the back line of said Survey to the Southeastly corner of Robt. Cochran Survey No 3466, thence on the back line of said last mentioned Survey S 37 E. and passing into Canaan Township to the Road running from Assity East to Franklin County line. Whereupon Thos. Timmond Britton & Eward and Johnathan Alder Viewed and Henry Alder Surveyor were appointed to meet at Jeremiah Somers on the 25th this inst and proceed to view Survey said Road and make Report to the next Meeting of this board.

1843 June 5th Report returned favorable and Road;

1843 Dec 5th No Objections being made the following is ordered to be recorded and declared a public highway to wit: Beginning in the Landon Road South Easterly corner to Elijah Peck's land, which is the upper back corner to Charles Symons Survey No 1479, and running S 37 E. to the North east corner of Robert Cochran Survey No 3466 and thence on the back line of last mentioned Survey course continued S 37 E. to the Road running from Assity to the county line. Whole distance Two Miles and sixty rods.
