 Improvement } Petition for Locating the Grading, Drainage and Graveling.

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said county, whose lands will be assessed for the proposed improvement hereinafter described respectfully represent that the public convenience requires locating the grading, drainage and graveling of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to wit:

Situated in the Township of Canaan, Survey No. 10081 and commencing at the south east corner of Moses V. Miller's land and the east end of the laneway to the lands of Memo A. Kauffman, in the line of the Lafayette and Plain City Road No. 8.

Thence running westerly with the center line of this road following the farm line of the lands of said Miller and Kauffman; and of Joseph Yoder, Jacob Farmwald, and A. B. Yoder and ending in the Converse and Huff Road being a distance of about one mile.

We represent that this road is necessary for public traffic east and west, saving a distance in travel of 3 1/2 miles.

We further represent that the cost of this improvement be apportioned and paid in the following manner:

40 per cent thereof shall be paid out of the proceeds of any levy or livies for road purposes upon the grand duplicate of all taxable property in the county, or out of any funds available therefor.

25 per cent of the total cost in said township shall be paid by each township respectively.

35 per cent shall be paid by the lands laying within one mile on either side thereof, and assessed according to benefits, as per Sec. 6919 of the revised statutes, article No. 1.

The Petition of K. A. Kauffman and others asking for the improvement of a Public Road known as the Kauffman Road by grading, drainage and graveling the same was presented to the Board.

On examination of said petition and the signatures thereto, it appears that at least fifty-one per cent of the land and lot owners, resident of this County, who are to be specially taxed or assessed for said improvement, have signed said petition.

It is therefore ordered that the County Commissioners go upon the line of said proposed improvement as described in the petition and view the same; that they meet on the 22nd day of April, 1924 at 10 o'clock A. M. at the east end of the laneway to the lands of Keno A. Kauffman in the line of the Lafayette-Plain City Road for that purpose, and that the Clerk of this Board notify the County Surveyor thereof, and request him to accompany the Commissioners upon said line.
