In the Matter of the Kilbury Road Disput.

A petition signed by Polly Kilbury ^{and} 52 other land holders whose lands will be accessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, praying for the improvement under the Two Mile Access and Pike Laws of Ohio of a road by grading, graveling, draining ^{and} culverting the route of a road along the following described route:

Beginning at a point in the County road known as the Middle Pike near the residence of Harvey Kilgore in Lancaster Twp. Madison Co. Ohio, thence in a westerly course along the lands of Harvey Kilgore, Nellie Athinson, Martha Francis, A. M. Huber, ^{and} Alice Huber, passing the residence of Alice Huber along the lands of Mrs. Kilbury (decd) Robert ^{and} Grace Milliken, Mrs. Athinson ^{and} Sarah Price a distance of about 2 1/2 miles to where said County road intersects with the Wilson ^{and} Whiget Pike near the residence of Abraham ^{and} that said road be of sufficient width for a double track. A good ^{and} sufficient bond signed by A. C. Willitt, H. P. Lowrey ^{and} Jerry Bradley in the sum of \$200.00 conditioned according to law has also been filed with said Board.

Whereupon the said board appointed W. E. Deals, S. S. Robinson ^{and} L. B. Wright as viewers ^{and} Dr. J. Lowrey as Engineer ^{and} directed them to meet at the residence of Harvey Kilgore on the 3rd day of April 1890 at 10 o'clock A. M. ^{and} after being duly sworn to take to their assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers ^{and} one marker ^{and} proceed to view, examine, lay out or straighten said road as in their opinions public utility ^{and} convenience require; to assess and determine the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the road is proposed to be laid out, straightened or improved; ^{and} to do such other things in the premises as are required of them by law, ^{and} to make a report of their proceedings in writing to this board at its next regular quarterly session on the 2nd day of June 1890. The Auditor is hereby directed to give notice as required by law.

It was moved by A. C. Willitt that all of the foregoing matter be approved, seconded by J. P. Bowers. Whereupon the clerk called the roll. Yeas, Willitt, Bowers ^{and} Lowrey. Nays, none.

Kilbury & Huber Road Improvement June 7th 1890

This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County Ohio met in regular session. Members present A. C. Willett, J. P. Cowers & C. H. Longbrunon

In the Matter of the N. M. Huber, & Kilbury Road Improvement

This being the day fixed by the Board for the further consideration of the above styled matter. The Board finds that the report of the viewers heretofore appointed has been made as required by law, said report being in favor of said improvement & showing that there is a public necessity therefor & the Board being satisfied by comparison & count of the petitioners for said improvement & land holders taxable therefor as reported by the viewers & by the testimony of H. P. Cowers & Lacey Millikin, that a majority of land owners whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the same have signed the petitions asking for said improvement.

that the public utility requires it & that the proceedings heretofore had were in conformity to law. The Board therefore order the reports & plat in said matter to be duly recorded & filed & said improvement to be made in the following manner to-wit:

Specifications

The grading to be done in accordance with the profile of the Engineer 24 ft. wide & crowning 4 inches to the center grade line thereof. The ditches must be graded so that the water will freely flow to the culverts.

Upon the road bed as above prepared & upon one side thereof must be spread a layer of clean gravel free from dirt or loam 11 ft. wide, 12 inches in the center & 10 inches at the edges, with all coarse gravel raked into the bottom of the gravel layer, in all 2151 cubic yards per mile, or 5189 yards in whole road.

All culverts must be made of first class sewer pipe 24 ft. long & the dimensions as required by the Engineer, the ends of each culvert must be protected by a stone wall 18 inches in thickness 3 ft. in length; with a coping stone on top & the whole laid with one part Leasville Cement & two parts sharp sand.

We do estimate the whole expense of said improvement at \$5,067.³⁰

Belbury & Heuber Road Improvmt.

The Board appoint Dr. J. Lawrence as Engineer to take charge of said improvement, to advertise & sell the same according to law, & require said work to be done by the day of 18" Payment for said work to be made in cash, but no payment will be made until after the sale of the Bonds for said improvement & for the purpose of raising money necessary to pay for said improvement. It is ordered that Bonds of the County be issued due at intervals of six months for the period of 7 years. Said bonds to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum payable semi-annually & the proper assessment placed upon the Road Duplicate for said Improvement as provided by law.

Said committee are directed to make report of their proceedings in writing, to this board at their earliest convenience. On the question of the passage of the foregoing order all the commissioners, Messrs. Willard, Powers & Soffbourn voted Aye.

Appportioning Committee.

The Board of Commissioners of Madison County, being in regular session as per adjournment of yesterday, J. P. Bowers, A. M. Loofbrouwer & A. C. Millikin being present and resumed the further considerations of said matter.

J. M. Willard, Scott Leckoweth & S. J. Burnham heretofore appointed by the Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, to appportion the expense of said Kilbury & Heuber road improvement, upon the real property reported by the assessors as benefited, having filed their report in the Auditor's Office of said County, and this being the day fixed for the hearing of said report and exceptions to the same, and the Commissioners having met to consider the matter & proof being made satisfactory to the Board that lawful notice had been given of the time & place set for said hearing, thereupon the same came on to be heard, & all persons interested were granted a hearing before the board including William Athinson who had filed exceptions in writing to the amount of his assessment.

After a careful examination of said report & hearing all exceptions thereto, the Board ordered that the assessment of William Athinson be reduced \$183.⁴³ making same \$900.⁵⁵ & that said report as hereby changed be approved & confirmed & that the Auditor place the same on a special duplicate for collection as required by law.

Upon the approval of all of the foregoing matter, the roll being called, each of the Commissioners (Bowers, Loofbrouwer, & Millikin) voted Aye,
