

Beginning at the South end of Center Street in Lafayette running S 78.20 poles thence  
 S 21 N. 63 poles thence S 16 N. 180 poles to the Lancaster Road, thence with said Road, S 34  
 N. 60 poles crossing Deer Creek at 20 poles to 1<sup>st</sup> Mile tree; Same course 14 poles to the  
 west line of Wm L. Davidson's land thence with the same & the land of John Davidson  
 S 26 E. 306 poles to 2<sup>nd</sup> Mile; Same course 24 poles to a line of Survey No 3903, thence  
 with the same S 20 E. 296 poles to 3<sup>rd</sup> Mile tree; & S. W. corner of said Survey crossing the  
 Jefferson Road at 216 poles. Thence with the line of Survey No 553 S 26 E. 320 poles to  
 crossing the Columbus Road at 288 poles to 4<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to 5<sup>th</sup>  
 Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to 6<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same course 250 poles the Birdline

Record of the State Road as located commencing on the National  
 Road 10 Miles West of Columbus and running S 11° 30' N. 320 poles to the 1<sup>st</sup>  
 Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to the  
 3<sup>rd</sup> Mile tree; Same course 298 poles to the Georgesville Road (So called) thence  
 with said Road S 72 N. 22 poles to the 4<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Thence N 80 N. 106 poles  
 thence S 57 N. 87 poles passing down the main street of Georgesville & crossing  
 Big Darby at ~~and~~ immediately below the mouth of Little Darby thence S 84 N.  
 52 poles thence S 62 N. 40 poles thence S 35 N. 40 poles to 5<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same course  
 320 poles to 6<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Thence S 29 N. 320 poles to 7<sup>th</sup> Mile tree, & the line between  
 the Counties of Franklin & Madison; Same course 12 poles thence S 15 N. 38 poles  
 thence S 22 N. 50 poles crossing the Big Run, thence S 31 N. 220 poles to 8<sup>th</sup> Mile  
 tree; Same course 152 poles, thence South with the line between Newland and  
 Rowland 168 poles to 9<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Thence S 21 N. 94 poles thence S 11 N. 108 poles  
 to a large stump in the line between Henderson & Ogleson, thence South 118 poles  
 passing the S. E. corner of Henderson's land to the 10<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same course 36  
 poles thence S 37.30 N. 284 poles to the 11<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to the  
 12<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same course 306 poles thence S 56 N. 14 poles to 13<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same  
 course 54 poles crossing Deer Creek, and John Keokuk Mill Race near where the  
 Mill stood, thence S 2 E. 60 poles thence S 23 N. 40 poles thence S 68 N. 166 poles  
 passing through John Graham's land to 14<sup>th</sup> Mile tree; Same course 92 poles  
 intersecting the Shellcote Road, near Wm B. Buffets Total distance 14 Miles  
 192 poles
