

1829 Dec 7<sup>th</sup>

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and survey of a road to begin at the N.E. corner of Worthington near pasture fence, running the best way to Levi Christy's field crossing Sugar Run near Worthington Old pasture fence thence the best way to John Braham's shop thence to Wilson's Mill, thence to Wm Oglesby's farm, & thence the best way to the County line in the direction of Georgesville

Ordered George McClimand, Wm Howdman, and Wm Johnston Viewers and Henry Warner Surveyor Meet at the place of Beginning on the 11<sup>th</sup> this inst and proceed to view Survey and Mark said Road and Make Report to this board at their next Meeting

1830 March 1<sup>st</sup>

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for an alteration of the road leading from London to Urbana Beginning near Christwells old house and running on the nearest direction so as to intersect the Old Road at or near the upper end of Christmans farm

Ordered by the Commissioners that Rea Wm Jones and Nathan Bond, Viewers and P. M. Lane Surveyor Meet at London on the 4<sup>th</sup> this inst and proceed to Survey and Mark said Alteration and Make Report thereof according to Law to the next Meeting of the board

1830 March 13<sup>th</sup>

P. M. Lane Surveyor Made Report that he had run said alteration Beginning near Christwells old house at a small white Oak in the edge of the road Marked S in the upper line of Robert Sharps Survey N. 58 77 and run N 84 W 128 poles thence S 42 1/2 W 332 poles to intersect the road again near the upper end of Christmans farm also run and measured the Old way and find the distance about the same and the Viewers Mathew Rea Wm Jones and Nathan Bond Made Report favorable to said alteration - Whereupon it is ordered by the Commissioners that said alteration be established and declared a public highway and that the Old way so far as altered be vacated

Decemb 7<sup>th</sup> 1830

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and survey of a road, from the County line near Palisade on the best and nearest route passing Wm Wilson's Mill and intersecting the London Road near Thos Dennison

Ordered that John Braham, Abraham Alkire and Johnathan Pannar, Viewers and Henry Warner Surveyor Meet at John Riccels on the 11<sup>th</sup> this inst and proceed to view and Survey said Road and Make Return thereof to this board, at their next Meeting according to Law

The above Return Report favorable Beginning at a point in the line between the Counties of Madison & Pickaway running N 66 W 50 poles to John Riccels House, thence same course 30 poles, thence N 73 W 26 poles, thence N 54 W 72 poles, thence N 20 W 108 poles, thence N 70 E, 66 poles, thence N 52 W 680 poles, thence N 20 W 348 poles, thence N 74 W 24 poles, thence S 54 W 42 poles, crossing Deer Creek at Wilson's Mill thence along said Mill Race N 39 W 30 poles, thence N 55 W 30 poles, thence N 68 W 32 poles, thence West 138 poles, passing John News house, thence N 63 W 168 poles to the Chillicothe Road, near where Thos Dennison lived Making a distance of five Miles and 214 poles
