At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and survey of a road commencing at the County line between Madison and Fayette at the end of the Jeffersonville Road, which was run from Jeffersonville in a direction to Midway and is now established to the County line, and to run straight at the ground will admit of to the fork of the Road between Samuel Hoffmann and Samuel McPherson =

Whereupon Isaac Howsman, John Bisher, and Benton Blyss and Brewer and Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Mr. Baird on the 19th this inst and proceed to view survey and Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to law =

1842 March 8th No Objections being Made the following Road is ordered to be recorded, declare a public highway and fence according to law = Beginning at a point where the Jeffersonville Road terminated at the line between the Counties of Fayette and Madison, at a point where a line runs S 48 E. from Mr. Baird house, will strike said County line, running from thence S 27 E. 117 poles, to the lower line of Edward Stubblefield's land, thence S 11 E. 114 poles to a large Red Oak, thence S 23 W. 89 poles to first mile tree; same course 60 poles to the S.W. corner of James McMillen's land, thence with his line South 88 poles to the fork of the Road between Samuel Hoffmann and Samuel McPherson

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County On application and Whersal it appearing to the Commissioners that the location of the Georgetown Road had become uncertain or so much thereof as it situated between Saml. Baird & the County line between Madison & Franklin Counties

Whereupon George Phipps, Stephen Moore, and John House Brewer and Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Saml. Baird on the 14th this inst and proceed to reestablish so much of said Road as lies between said points agreeably to law & Make Report to the next Meeting of this board

1841 Dec 7th Report returned Establishing the following as the true Road.

Beginning at a point where the Spring Valley Road, and at a point where the latter Made in said Road by Saml. Baird terminated, running from thence on or near the former location of said State Road S 80 E. 96 poles thence 73 1/2 E. 172 poles (crossing between the lands of Joel Painter & Sarah Papp) thence S 69 E. 52 poles first mile, same course 93 poles to John Cox's field, crossing through the land of John Byrd, thence S 83 E. 227 poles 2^d mile; same course 12 poles to a large Red Oak in James Parkers land thence with the same S 70 E. 95 poles to the Road leading from Popcorn Run to Jefferson, thence S 87 E. 62 poles to a point on the South side of said Road; thence S 86 E. 157 poles crossing said River
