

Holland Road

June 3rd 1839

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented by George L. Holland, praying for an alteration of the county road known by the name of Holland Road, in the Township of Fairfield commencing at a small highway near G. L. Holland South line where said road intersects said Holland line, thence parralel west with said line fourteen poles etc intersect the River Road

Whereupon George Hume, Charles Henderson and Edward Gitzger all Viewed and Eliad L. Warner Surveyor were appointed to Meet at G. L. Holland on the 29th June next and proceed to view, survey and Make report to the next Meeting of this board according to Law - provided the applicant Holland pay all costs -

1839 Dec 2nd Returned favorable and read

1840 March 3rd No objections being filed the following alteration is ordered to be recorded, and declared a public highway to wit; Beginning at a highway near said Holland South line where the said Road intersects said Holland line, thence parralel west with said line 17 poles intersecting what is called the River Road

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a road as follows: commencing on the East bank of Big barby where the county line crosses said creek, on Joseph Charrow's land, thence up said creek until opposite the corner of Henderson's tract, Alvin Harrington's land, thence across said creek to said corner, & thence on the line to the State Road, & cross the Road & running on said line & same course, til it intersects the county road leading from Jefferson to Madison Hundred.

Whereupon, John Hunter, James Milliken & Paul Smith Viewed and Henry Alder Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Jacob Francis on the 14th this inst and proceed to view and survey said Road and Make report to the next Meeting of this board according to law -

1840 June 1st Report returned favorable and read

1840 Dec 8th No objections being filed the following Road is ordered to be recorded & opened according to law to wit; commencing at the county line between Madison and Franklin in the mouth of the lane between Thoncutten Bailey & Joseph Charrow. It dett^r thence up the creek on the bank thereof N 44 W. 46 poles, thence S 18 W. 34 poles, thence N 27 W. 34 poles, thence N 44 W. 17 poles, thence N 65 W. 31 poles, thence S 53 W. 45 poles, crossing the creek to brabbs corner, thence with his line 108 poles to the State Road; course continued on brabbs line 50 poles 1st Mile; same course continued 320 poles 2nd Mile; same course 30 poles to the County Road leading from S. M. Hunter to Jefferson
