

Mechanicsburg & Saverpool Road Improv.

A petition signed by Wm. P. Patrick ^{and} five other land holders whose lands will be affected for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the said Joint Board of Commissioners of Champaign ^{and} Madison Counties, Ohio praying for the improvement under the Two Mile Act recent Pike Laws of Ohio of a road by straightening, grading sufficiently wide to admit of side track, graveling, bridging, ditching ^{and} subverting the same of a road along the following described route:

Beginning at the Soudan ^{and} Liverpool Turnpike near the Burrham ^{and} Joseph Williams School house; thence in a westerly direction following the present road to the north westerly corner of S. Browns Land, thence straight to end of fill on east side of Iron Bridge near residence of Wm Patrick thence following the present road to its intersection with the Mechanicsburg ^{and} Liverpool Turnpike at the south west corner of Genl F. Cummings land in Champaign County ^{and} about four miles of easterly portions being in Madison County, and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile of westerly portions being in Champaign County.

A good and sufficient bond required by Wm. P. Patrick in the sum of \$200.⁰⁰ Dollars, with Chas. F. Sanford as surety thereon, conditioned according to law has also been filed with said Joint Board. Thereupon said Joint Board appointed Wm. E. Beals ^{and} Chas. Slyk of Madison County ^{and} Warren S. Sibley of Champaign County, three disinterested free holders of the said Counties as viewers ^{and} Joseph J. Ware of Champaign County as Surveyor ^{and} directed them to meet at the Burrham ^{and} Joseph Williams School house in Meador township, Madison County, on Monday the 7th day of March 1892 at 10 o'clock A.M. ^{and} after being duly sworn to take to their assistance two suitable persons, as chain carriers ^{and} one marker ^{and} proceed to view, examine, lay out or straighten said road as in their opinion public utility ^{and} convenience require; to assess and determine the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the road is proposed to be laid out, straightened or improved ^{and} to do such other things in the premises as are required by law, ^{and} to make report of their proceedings in writing to this Joint Board at its next regular session on Tuesday the 15th day of March 1892, at 10 o'clock A.M.

The Auditor of Madison County is hereby directed to give notice as required by law.

Upon each of the several orders ^{and} findings of said Commissioners the roll being called, each of the said Commissioners Jacob M. Moran, John W. Rock, Jacob S. Sarver, A. L. Millikin ^{and} M. L. Rea agreed thereto.
