

Ordered that Samuel Culbertson John Davidson and Asa Wright be and are hereby appointed Viewers of a road petitioned for by sundry Inhabitants of Union ^{& Danbury} Townships for a road to commence at the North Mouth of Main Croft Street in the Town of Landon running from thence on the nearest and ground by or near the house of Mrs Davidson intersecting the State Road leading from Franklinton to Springfield at or near the house of Samuel Culbertson and Ordered that Robert Hume be and he is hereby appointed Surveyor That said Viewers and Surveyor meet at the house of Robt Hume in Landon on Friday the 13th day of July next, then and there proceed to view & run said Road and Make Report thereof to the next board of Commissioners

We do hereby acknowledge ourselves securely for the costs of the last above mentioned Road provided it should not be carried into effect Witness our hands and Seals this 4th day of June 1821

The Return of the following road was Ordered to be received by the Commissioners: In Compliance with your Order to me directed I proceeded on the 17th inst to survey the road beginning at the post Road near Samuel Ruffels in Danby Township Thence past Samuel Smiths thence between John Eastmans and Charles Andrews lands; thence past two school houses & several lines to intersect the post Road near Samuel Hards to wit the Survey as follows: Beginning at the post Road near Samuel Ruffels thence S 88. E. 427 poles & Mark the 1st Mile tree at 320 poles; Thence N 83. E. 140 poles passing Smiths house at 20 poles Thence S 57. E. 305 poles & Mark the 2^d Mile tree Thence S 88. E. 68 poles thence S 72. E. 182 poles & Mark the 3^d Mile tree Thence S 84. E. 244 poles & Mark the 4th Mile tree at 860 poles to a City Road and near a school house Thence with said Road N 7 1/2. E. 46 poles thence on Asas Beachs North line S 82. E. 140 poles, thence N 87. E. 92 poles and Mark the 5th Mile tree; Thence S 88. E. 92 poles thence N 69. E. 52 poles, thence N 65. E. 122 poles Crossing a City Road at 114 poles thence N 25. E. 38 poles Crossing Danby Creek at 4 poles, thence with a line N 53. E. 492 poles Marked the 6th Mile tree at 8 poles Crossing Sugar run at 96 poles Marked the 7th Mile tree at 328 poles and intersected the Post Road near Samuel Hards
