At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a Petition was presented praying for a view and Survey of a Road as follows Beginning in the County Road at the line between Saml Mannel & Norman Mitchell in Pike Township, thence a South East Course on said line to intersect the line between P. W. Allen, & Ira Stacy; thence on said line to intersect the line between Pharo Blument & Tho. M. Beyley thence on said line to intersect the line between James Brown & M. J. Patrick in Monroe Township thence on said line to the South East corner of said Brown's tract, and thence on the most direct way course to intersect the London & Melford Road at the Mouth of Charles Guys Lane near the New School house in Dist No 5 =

Whereupon James C. Gier, Abner S. Millard, & Solomon Weaver, Viewers and Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Saml Mannel on the 23rd this inst & proceed view & Survey said Road, and Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to Law =

1837 March 6th

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view & Survey of a Road, commencing at a point in the State Road leading from the National Road, to William Bruffets where the South line of Survey No 6260 crossed said Road; thence with the line of said Survey East & 8586 to the South line of Edward Fitzgerald's land, & with the same to his S.W. corner, & with another line thereof to a point where the Road from London to Birchville crossed Oposum Run =

Whereupon John Simmond, John Graham, & John Riddle Viewers and H. Warner Surveyor were appointed to Meet at John Ricks on the 1st April 1837 and proceed to view & Survey said Road, & Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to Law =

1837 June 5th Report returned favorable and read =

1837 Dec 5th The following Road was ordered to be recorded and of fund according to law as a public highway to wit = Beginning at a point in the State Road leading from the National Road to Wm Bruffets where the South line of Survey No 6260 crossed said Road, running from thence with the line of said Survey East 188 fms to the South corner of said Survey, & with another line thereof 8586 132 fms 1st Mile; Same course 320 fms 2nd Mile; Same course 40 fms to the west line of Edward Fitzgerald's land & with the same, 826 N. 60 fms to his S.W. corner, thence with another line thereof 8716 100 fms intersecting with the Road leading from Birchville to London where said Road crossed Oposum Run
