

O. Day Road Improvement.
March 6th 1889.

This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio met in regular session, members present Wm. E. Beale, A. C. Willett and J. P. Bowers.

In the Matter of the O. Day Road Improvement.

A petition signed by A. M. Lofbourn, and one hundred and twenty three other land holders, whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, praying for the improvement under and in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes of Ohio relating to Two Miles Assessment Pikes and for the extension and improvement of said road under said act by grading, graveling and constructing the necessary bridges and culverts on the following described route.

Beginning at the intersection of said O. Day road with the London & Mt. Sterling Pike near Mt. Sterling Ohio, widening said road ten feet to now 40 ft. wide thence on the line of said road in westerly course to the Miller road, so called, thence bearing slightly to the north across said Miller road to the old grade of the R. J. & C. Railroad, thence with the line of said railroad grade to the Danville & Yankee towns Pikes, near old Bethel Church in Range Township, we further represent that said Road is now laid out to said Miller road, a distance of about two miles and that from that point we respectfully ask that said Road may be laid out fifty ft. wide and all improvements as herein before described. Your petitioners further represent that they are a majority of the land owners whose lands will be assessed for said improvement, the ground along said proposed improvement is low and wet so that said road is of but little use one half of the year, we therefore ask that your honorable Board may take such steps as may be necessary so that said road may be laid out and improved as herein prayed for.

A good and sufficient bond signed by A. M. Lofbourn and Geo. Horubek, in the sum of Two Hundred & \$200⁰⁰ Dollars conditioned according to law has also been filed with said Board, thereupon said Board appointed Robert Boyl, Saml. Tralick and Jno. A. Beale three disinterested free-holders of the County as viewers and Wm. Beeder as Surveyor or Engineer and direct them to meet at Mt. Sterling, Madison County O. on Monday the 29th day of April 1889 at 10 o'clock A.M. and after being duly sworn to take to your assistance two suitable persons as check-cashers and proceed to view, examine, lay out, or straighten said road as in their opinion public utility and convenience requires to assess and determine the damages sustained by any person through whose lands the road is proposed to be laid out, straightened or improved and to do such things in the premises as are required of them by law and to make a report of their proceedings in writing to this Board at its next regular session on the 3rd day of June 1889.

The Auditor is hereby directed to give notice as required by law in such cases.

Upon motion of J. P. Bowers a vote was taken upon all of the above

Regular Session June 7th 1889.

This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio met in regular session. Pursuant to recess taken yesterday.
 Members present W. E. Beale, A. C. Willett & J. P. Bowers.

In the Matter of the Ad Day Road Improvement

The report of the viewers here tofore appointed having been made as required by law, ^{and} said report being in favor of said improvement ^{and} showing that there is a public necessity therefor ^{and} the Board being satisfied by a comparison ^{and} count of the petitioners for said improvement ^{and} land holders taxable therefor as reported by the viewers ^{and} other evidence that a majority of land owners, whose lands would be assessed for the expense of the same, have signed the petitions asking for said improvement (said majority being 31) that public utility requires it ^{and} that the proceedings here tofore had were in conformity to law.

The Board therefore order the reports ^{and} plat in said matter to be duly recorded ^{and} filed with and said improvement be made in the following manner to wit

Specifications

1. That the road be opened to a width of 20 ft on each side of its center line.
2. That the road be cleared of all obstructions to a width of 20 ft on each side of its center line by grubbing all trees ^{and} stumps from cuts ^{and} side ditches ^{and} by cutting them off even with the ground in fills.
3. That the road bed must be smoothly ^{and} evenly graded to a width of 11 feet on each side of ^{and} crowning six inches to its center line with side slopes of $1\frac{1}{2}$ horizontal to 1 vertical leaving 2 feet berm of unbroken earth at base of all fills with center street grade ^{and} horizontal lines never making a greater angle than 1 in 20.
4. That all side ditches be made not less than 2 ft wide in bottom ^{and} that the bottoms be not less than 2 feet below the center street grade line over the road with side slopes of 1 to 1 unobstructed ^{and} continuous leaving no ponds nor pools in side ditches with complete drainage to all culverts.
5. That all culverts must be made side walls of stone covered with flagging where 6 ft clear span ^{and} under ^{and} over 6 ft clear span to be covered with best twifty white or bur oak flooring ^{and} joints or if made of timber will be made known on day of sale.

6. That upon the road bed as above prepared there be spread uniformly a layer of clean gravel free from dirt, loam or fine sand 12 feet wide 14 inches deep in center ^{and} 10 inches at sides on the center line of gravel upon center line of grade raising all coarse gravel into the bottom of the gravel layer, leaving no stone that can not pass through a 2 1/2 inch ring mesh that 4 inches of the top of gravel grade in all 23.47 cubic yards per mile.
7. That the grubbing, clearing, grading, ditching ^{and} culverting must be completed in parcels of not less than 80 rods as above to the acceptance of the Engineer before the graveling of any such parcel is commenced.
8. Each section of one half mile when completed to the acceptance of the Engineer ^{and} Commissioners of Madison County O. will be received ^{and} paid for in full, road to be completed on or before December 10th 1889.
9. Eighty per cent payments made monthly upon the engineer's certificate as the work progresses in each.
10. For full particulars see ordered Specifications ^{and} filled, book of road which will be made part of contract at Auditor's Office on ^{and} after July 20th 1889.
11. Bond ^{and} security for the faithful performance of the work must be given ^{and} bidder must present their sureties on the ground with the Engineer a written certificate of same agreeing to join in bond with such bidder, should his bid be accepted before the bid of any such bidder be entertained.

The Board appoint Lieut Moore as engineer to take charge of said improvement, to advertise ^{and} sell the same according to law, ^{and} require said work to be done by the day of 1889, payment for said work will be made in cash but no payment will be made until after the sale of the bonds for said improvement ^{and} for the purpose of raising money necessary to pay for said improvement it is ordered that the bonds of the county be issued of equal amounts due at intervals for six months for the period of years.

Said bonds bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum payable semi-annually ^{and} the proper assessment be placed upon the road duplicate as provided in section 4846, Rev. Statutes of Ohio.

The Board find that the following lands will be benefited by said improvement ^{and} should be assessed to pay the same tax:
