At a Meeting of the Commissioners 1st March 1824 a petition was presented praying for a view to be appointed to view and locate a road Beginning at the Crop Street in London and running the nearest and best way to the County line near Brooks then to intersect a road leading from Charleston to Clark City

Ordered that Agulla Polance Nathan Bond, & Hugh McSammy view and P. McLane Surveyor meet at London on the 3^d Monday in May next and proceed to view locate & survey said road and make report thereof to this board at their next Meeting

12 At the same time a petition was presented praying for a view to be appointed to view and report a small alteration in the Washington or Genia Road at the corner of George Shifers fence - Ordered that Ephraim Dawson, Thos Ray, and Saml M. Thompson, view and P. McLane Surveyor to meet at London on the 1st Monday in May next and proceed to view and measure said alteration and make report thereof to the board at their next Meeting

12 At the same time a petition was presented praying for a view to be appointed to view and report an alteration in Genia Road. Beginning at McLeins Bridge and intersect said road again at or near S. Watsons field - Ordered that J. Minshall & Chappell, and Hugh McSammy view and P. McLane Surveyor to meet at any time between this & Dec next at London, & proceed to view and measure said alteration and make report to this board at their Dec Meeting

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of the County of Madison in the State of Ohio. Present Burtan Blyggard, and Ira Finch Esq. on the Eleventh day of June 1824 - This day came A. Polance and N. Bond, two of the viewrs appointed at March last to view a road prayed for from London to the County line near Brooks & and returned their report which was examined and read.

June 12th 1824

The Commissioners met present same as yesterday and the above report being taken up and read. Whereupon Mr. Brighton by his agent objected to said road running through his land, and prayed to have his damagel apesed Therefore it is ordered that John McDaniel, John S. Chenoweth, John Davalson, Jacob Boon, and William Vincent; that they meet at London on the 21st day of August - 1824 and proceed to examine the land where the above road crosses the same and apes the damagel in consequence of said road running where reported by viewrs; also that they examine the land of said Brighton and if they can run said road so as to quiet the objections and not injure the public they are requested to do so
