Thence on the best route to Urbana, as far as the west boundary of Madison County. Order issued bearing date 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1810 Viewers names = James Ewing, William Chard, & George G. Roberts. And Joshua Ewing Surveyor, of said Road. At a meeting of the Commissioners on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1810, a petition was presented by William Frankbarger praying for viewers to be appointed on a Road beginning at Thomas Swynne, on the Franklin Road. Thence on the right and best direction past John Peppers, to William Frankbarger. Order issued bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> December 1810 - Returnable to March Meeting. Attest W. G. Clerk. At a meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1810 a petition was presented by John Blain, praying for viewers to be appointed on a Road leading from the east boundary of Madison County, between three and four miles from the North East Corner, thence on the right and best direction to Blairsville in said County. Order granted bearing date 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1810. Viewers = William Chard, John Blain and Abijah Cary. And Joshua Ewing Esq. Surveyor to said Road. At a meeting of Commissioners of Madison County, a petition was presented to said board by P. Lewis Esq. praying that viewers may be appointed, to make an alteration in the State Road leading from Rees Prices in Butler County to John Swynne formerly in Franklin County, now in Madison, may be made from the sixty fourth mile tree, to run the right and best way so as to intersect the Road from Franklinton to Dayton, at or near the twenty fifth mile tree. Order issued - John Beatty, Daniel Brown, & W<sup>m</sup> Blain viewers & Patrick McLure Surveyor of said Road. Attest W<sup>m</sup> Gibson Clerk C.M.C.

To the Commissioners of Madison County. Gentlemen in obedience to your direction, we proceeded on the 20<sup>th</sup> inst. to view and examine the ground on which the alteration of the Road from Rees Prices, to John Swynne, was prayed for, from the 64<sup>th</sup> mile tree till it intersects the Road from Franklinton to Dayton, at or near the 25<sup>th</sup> mile tree; and are of opinion that said Road will be on better ground, than the old Road, and the distance much shortened, and that said Road if opened would be of Public and general utility.
