ROAD PETITION

Section 6907 etc.

To the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said county, whose lands will be assessed for the proposed improvement hereinafter described respectfully represent that the public convenience require the reconstructing by grading, drainage and stonewalling of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit:

Situated in the County of Madison, and township of Canaan as follows: Commencing at the point of intersection of the Price & Hilliards Road No. 32 with the Lafayette and Plain City Road No. 51; thence running westerly with the line of said Price Hilliards Road to the London and Delaware Road No. 241, and there to terminate, being a total distance of about three miles.

We further represent that the construction of this is a necessity.

We further ask that the cost of this improvement be apportioned and paid in the following manner:

40 per cent thereof shall be paid out of the proceeds of any levy or levies for road purposes in the county, or out of any funds available therefore.

25 per cent of the total cost in each of said townships shall be paid by said townships respectively.

35 per cent shall be paid by the lands laying within one mile on either side thereof, and assessed according to the benefits, as per Section 6919, of the revised statutes, article No. 1.

---SPECIFICATIONS---

Preparing Roadbed and Excavation.

Under the heading of "Preparing Roadbed and Excavation" shall be included all excavations required for the formation of the roadbed, sufficient opening and grading of ditches to carry the water to an outlet at the sides of the road, preparing foundations and hauling and depositing the excavated materials wherever required to fill depressions in the roadbed.

The shaping of the roadbed to conform to the width as shown on plans submitted herewith.

Subgrade

The gravel now on the road shall be scarified or loosened up and spread to a width of ten feet to form a bed on which the new road material shall be placed.

As nearly as possible all of the gravel now on the road shall be used for a foundation for the new material and shall be shaped to give the finished road the crown as shown in the drawings.

Low places along the side shall be filled up and leveled so as to make smooth and uniform berms. Dirt for this purpose may be taken from the side ditches.

Size of Material.

Material to be crusher run, sized from $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches down to dust. Dust or Screenings of No. 6 size not to exceed 25% of the total aggregate.

rolled Stone Course.

After the roadbed has been prepared and accepted by the Engineer, a layer of broken stone of the approved size and quality shall be spread evenly over it to the required width and depth.

Depth of stone, loose 8 in. in center and 6 in. on sides.

All stone to be thoroughly compacted by rolling with a ten ton roller.
