At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was
presented by Gabriel Marshall praying for a view and survey of a County Road to
commence at the West end of the Town of Summersford, and running Southwesterly
until it intersects the London & Springfield Road at or near Jacob Garrison's farm

Whereupon John H. Kennedy, Joseph C. Beer and Wm. Hull Beems
and Elisha Warner Surveyors were appointed to Meet at Summersford on the 14th
this inst and proceed to view, survey and mark said Road, and Make Report
to the next Meeting of this board according to Law

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1840 March 2^o Report Returned favorable and Road

1840 June 2^o No Objection that was considered legal being filed the following
Road is ordered to be located and declare a public highway to wit: Beginning near
the West end of Summersford, running thence S 19 N. 52 E. 1/2 m. to the edge of a prairie
thence S 1/2 E. 44 N. 1/2 m. to Robert's Mill; thence S 6 1/2 N. 84 E. to the Springfield Road
