

March 7th 1826

At a meeting of the Commissioners a petition was presented praying for viewers to be appointed to locate a road beginning at the Post Road near Asa Plummer on Little Darby thence to pass his house across the bridge and from thence passing to the East of Archibald Bates house, thence west of and near to Samuel Burnhams building, thence East of and near to George Sullingtons building, thence the nearest and best way to where the Widow Rasbury formerly lived on the Spring fork of Darby, thence the nearest and best route to intersect the State Road about one mile South of Peter Paught. Whereupon it was ordered that David Bradley, Josiah Bradley and Wm. Clarm Viewers and David Chapman Surveyor meet at Asa Plummer on the first June next and proceed to view and survey said road and make report to the next meeting of this board.

In compliance with your Order to me directed I proceeded on the 1st inst to survey the road beginning at the Post Road near Asa Plummer thence S. E. 70 p. across Little Darby at 68 poles S 10 E. 360 poles passing A. L. Bates house S 21 E. 116 poles to S Burnhams S 28 E. 158 p. to G Sullingtons S 35 E 104 p. S 52 E. 108 p. S 30 E. 88 p. S 20 E. 136 p. South 58 p. S 9 E. 108 p. S 15 E. 122 p. S 33 E. across the fork at the widow Rasburys old place at 8 p. S 19 E. 102 p. S 15 E. 114 p. S 12 E. 278 p. S 24 E. 652 p. to intersect the State Road nearly one mile South of Peter Paught Making Eight Miles 174 p. S. C.

June 4th 1827

At a meeting of the Commissioners a petition was presented praying for viewers to be appointed to locate a road beginning at the County line before John Lattimore thence so as to strike the N. E. corner of John Fishers plantation thence the nearest and best way to the South West corner of Isaac Howmans place thence with Jacob Howmans line as he may direct to intersect the Federal Road below the Baldwins. Whereupon it was ordered that Wm. Hall, Richd. Ayres and George McClimant Viewers and Henry Warner Surveyor meet at John Lattimore the 16th this instant proceed to view survey and report thereon to the next meeting of the board,

At the same time a petition was received praying for an alteration in the Post Road, to run to the right of the present road near Simon Hagers East line running straight about 100 rods to intersect said road at or near Abner Chappmans land. Whereupon Titus Sart, Richard Taylor, & Eliza Hards Viewers and David Chapman Surveyor are appointed to view survey and make report thereof to the next meeting of the board to meet at S Hagers the 16th this inst
