At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and survey of an alteration in the County Road leading from Palatine in Pickaway County to London by Kious Mills. Alteration to commence at the East corner, of Isaac Murphy's land thence N 69 E. 40 poles, thence the nearest and best route to intersect the line between Madison & Pickaway Counties at or near the Mouth of Richard Heath's lane.

Whereupon John Sullivan, George Hornback, and Wm. Crath & Viewers and Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed by the Commissioners to Meet at John Piggel's on the first day of May next and view survey and Make report according to Law to the next Meeting of their board.

1833 June 3rd Report Returned favorable and Read

1833 Dec 3rd No legal objections being presented the following alteration is Ordered to be Recorded and declared a public highway: Beginning at a Stake 2 poles South of Bell's Isaac Murphy's North East corner, and in the aforesaid Road running from thence N 69 E. 40 poles, thence S 71 E. 140 poles, to a Stake, and large white Oak said to be the line between the Counties of Pickaway and Madison at the Mouth of Heath's lane

24 At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and survey of a Road beginning in Darby Township at the Road leading by Jeremiah Conners to London, and at the end of the lane between the lands of Jeremiah Conners & Anne Charles Conners, thence in a Westerly direction with said lane, to the end of it, thence in a direction, to intersect the South line of Richard Smith's land, at the S.E. corner of his field, thence with the said Smith's line till it struck Richard Morgan's land, thence across said lane till it struck the line between the said Morgan's and Chester Alden's land east of said Alden's house, thence on the west side of said line to the said Alden's South corner thence on the line between the said Alden and J. P. Lombard's land, to the said Lombard's S.W. corner, thence in a direction to strike the S.E. corner of George Clement's land, thence with the said Clement's South line to his S.W. corner, thence across the land of Wm. J. Morgan to the corner of George Meason & John Hector's land, thence with the line between the said Meason & Hector till it intersects the London Road, on Little Darby at the end of a lane that is between the land of J. B. Andrews & others, thence with said lane Westerly until it intersects the Road leading to Mechanicsburgh at Rosedale in Pike Township (To June) Whereupon Jeremiah Conroy, John W.
