

from Delaware it laid to the fork on Treach's creek where Charles Culver now lived. Also another petition was presented by said inhabitants praying for an alteration of the road from the East boundary of Madison County on the route to Urbana it laid out, from the fork above Samuel Ewing to the line of Champaign County. Nathum King, Elijah Cary, and Robert Nelson were appointed Viewers, and Joshua Ewing Surveyor on the foregoing Road. to Meet the 2<sup>d</sup> Monday in Nov next at the house of Allen Seifer for the first, and the next day at the same place for the 2<sup>d</sup> Road, and Make Report to the next board of Commissioners.

5<sup>th</sup> Decemb 1814

The Commissioners Met Present Joshua Ewing and Jonathan Minshall. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Commissioners that the above Order could not be carried into effect it is therefore Ordered that the said Viewers Meet on the second Monday in February Next at the same place for the first and the next day for at the same place for the second Road, and that P Lewis be appointed Surveyor.

5<sup>th</sup> March 1816

At a Meeting of the Commissioners. Ordered that the different County Roads within Madison County be opened the width herein mentioned. Viz The Road from Eyed Mill up Big Lark 3 Rods; The Road from Worthington to Urbana 3 Rods; The Road from Reynolds to Frankenburg 30 feet; The Road from London to the North west corner of Pickaway County 3 Rods; The Road from Urbana to Chillicothe by Walnut Run 3 Rods; The Road from London towards Urbana 3 Rods; The Road from Fayette County line by Samuel Kents to intersect the Federal Road 3 Rods; The Road from Burlington towards Urbana 30 feet. Ordered that the Clerk of the Commissioners forthwith issue Order to the Trustees of the several Townships to have the above Roads opened accordingly including the Road from John Erwin land to Delaware line 3 Rods; The Road from Elias Heinkles towards Franklinton 2 Rods; The Road from the forks of Urbana.

5<sup>th</sup> March 1816

At a Meeting of the Commissioners a petition was presented praying for a road to be opened beginning at the end of the Washington Road at the County line and thence to run in the best direction and on the best ground so as to intersect the travel Road leading from Chillicothe to Springfield near the farm of Philip Hedrick.

An Order of Viewers and Survey was granted, and Nelson Samuel Herrod, and Samuel Hornback was appointed Viewers and M Cally Bowen Surveyor to Make Report to the next board of Commissioners.

At the same Meeting a petition was presented for a Road beginning on the County Road about fifteen or twenty Rods, above Masid Mitchels field thence the nearest and best way to intersect the State Road, at the Bridge near George Sagers, thence the nearest and best way to Delaware County line, near Andrew Hills where a Road in the adjacent County begins.

A View granted and James Russell, Israel Lockwood, and

Nicholas Moon, were appointed viewers and service Chapman surveyor to make report to the next Meeting of the Commissioners

At the same Meeting a petition was presented for a Road beginning at a bridge near Robert Cummins in Stoked Township where the Road from Urbana to Chillicothe intersects the old Road from Springfield to Chillicothe and continuing in a direction with said old Road through Charleston to the line between Madison & Greene Counties a distance of about two miles: Viewers appointed to wit; Isaac Scauden, Sr Pringle and Richard Creamer, M<sup>c</sup>Bally Rowan Surveyor and make report to the next board of Commissioners

To the board of Commissioners of Madison County, Agreeable to your Order to us directed we proceeded on the 13<sup>th</sup> of December to view a Road beginning at the forks of Urbana and Reed Mill Road and thence intersecting the State Road from Mitchell's Settlement to Seymour near Peter Paugh which in our opinion is the best way to Seymour, and that if the said Road should be opened will be of public utility; Given under our hands this 13<sup>th</sup> December 1815
