Moon Road in a south-westerly direction about 230 rods to the corner of the lands of John L. Moon and J. L. Moon; thence with the center of said Moon road in a westerly direction about 100 rods; thence with the center of the said Moon Road in a southerly direction about 370 rods to the Federal Pike and there terminating; a distance in all of about seven miles.

Kilgore and one hundred and twenty-five others, land holders whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, praying for the improvement, under the Two Mile Assessment Pike Laws of Ohio, by grading, graveling, ditching and culverting the same, along the following described route, to wit: Beginning at a point in the center of the London and Midway Pike where the Delsor Road intersects the said London and Midway pike; thence with the center of the said Delsor road in a westerly course about four and one-half miles to the center of the old Whillie's road, where the same is intersected by the said Delsor Road, and being the south-west corner of school lot; Thence with the center of said Whillie's road in a southerly direction about 65 rods to the intersection of the John S. Moon road; Thence with the center line of said John S. Moon road in a southwesterly direction about 230 rods to the corner of lands of John S. Moon and J. S. Removing Obstructions: - The area required for the road bed and ditches to be cleared of all obstructions, trees, bushes and brush, said trees, bushes and brush to be removed by grubbing, if engineer deems necessary and must be burned or taken out of the limits of the road. Any tree that the engineer shall designate shall be left standing and if necessary must be trimmed by the contractor so that loaded vehicles may pass under the branches. All earth, rubbish or other matter liable to obstruct the water way or outlet of any sewer must be removed by the contractor to a depth deemed by the engineer, sufficient for the necessary water way.</p>
