

## W Warners Road alteration

June 3<sup>o</sup> 1839

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented by <sup>R. W. Warners</sup> praying for an alteration in the County Road, that lead by John Lotters into London, so as to lead from the Mouth of John Lotters Lane on the line between Wm Warners and John Rousel lands, until it intersects the Road, from London to Jefferson at a bridge near the corner of Wm Warners fence and so into London with the Jefferson road.

Whereupon Nathaniel Whitens, John Rayburn and Jacob Thompson Owens and Elias L. Warner, Surveyors were appointed to meet at Wm Warners on the 15<sup>th</sup> this inst and proceed to view & survey said alteration and make report to the next Meeting of the Coms. according to law provided the applicant pay all costs.

1839 Dec 2<sup>d</sup> Report returned favorable and Road

1840 March 3<sup>o</sup> No Objections being filed, and being satisfied that the new way is as good as the old way, the following alteration is ordered to be received, and declared a public highway and the old way vacated to wit: Beginning at the S. E. corner of Wm Warners land near the Mouth of John Lotters Lane, running from thence S 21 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 140 poles with the line between Wm Warners and John Rousel lands to the S. W. corner of John Rousel lands, thence S 41 E. 44 poles to the corner of Wm Warners field, thence S 21 E 20 poles to the Turnpike Road leading from Jefferson to London, thence with the said Road S 65 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 200 poles to the end.

## Jacksons Road

June 3<sup>o</sup> 1839

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented by Joseph Jackson praying for a view and survey of a Road to commence at a point in the Seaburn Road, in the west line of Phasal Jackson to run Easterly to his North line between him & Stephen Morris, thence with Morris & Jacksons line to the East end of Jacksons land, thence an Easterly course to Jacksons Mill road, at the West line of Amos Morris Blackwell farm, thence with or near said Mill Road to the County line in the Kingsville Road. Whereupon Jacob Coon, Wm B. Snye, & Mathew Rice (Breeds) & Henry Warner Surveyors were appointed to meet at Phal Jacksons on the 22<sup>d</sup> this inst & proceed to view, survey & make report to the next Meeting of this board according to law.

1839 Dec 2<sup>d</sup> Report returned favorable and Road

1840 March 3<sup>o</sup> Objections being laid in against the establishment of said Road when the same is continued until next Meeting

1840 June 2<sup>d</sup> a petition being filed by John Byrd for a review of said Road, whereupon John Stroop, Job Coburn, and Davie Mattson, Amos Evans & Phal Snye, were appointed to meet at Saml A. Ains on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October next and proceed to review said Road, and make report to the next Meeting of this board.

1840 Dec 7<sup>th</sup> The above named not having met on application of John Davidson, Saml P. Kure, John Ewing, Jefe Stout & Jacob Liden were appointed to meet at Saml A. Ains on the 4<sup>th</sup> Jan 1841 and proceed to review said Road and make report to the next Meeting of this board according to law.
