

Wattens, Sagar Mill Road Boston

1837 Dec 4th

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At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a Vacation of so much of the Sagar Mill Road, as lies between the Lafayette & Robinson Mill Road, on the East Side of Darby Creek and the National Road, some distance East of Lafayette Road and laid over until the next Meeting

1838 March 5th No Objections being Made the above petition is granted and so much of said Road as prayed for is declared vacated

Knaps Road Alteration

June 5th 1837

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At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for an alteration in the South end of the Road leading from the East Road, on the East Side of Darby Creek to leave said Road on the line between Washington Lewis and Elisha Knaps, and continuing on a line between Johnson, & Lewis to the Creek, continuing down on the bank of said Creek, to Annanias Harriell upon corner on the bank of the Creek; from thence in a straight direction to intersect the Road leading from the National Road up Darby Creek, near the house of Annanias Harriell at Franklin County line

Whereupon Samuel Kilgore, Neham King, & Johnathan Allen, Brewood and James Milliken Surveyor were appointed to Meet at Elisha Knaps on the 31st this inst. and proceed to view, survey and Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to law =

1837 Dec 4th Report Returned favorable and Read;

1838 March 6th Leander Stone claimed damages for said Road running through his premises. Whereupon John Hunter, James Balhoon, and Abert Beeton, were appointed to Meet on the 26th of May next at said Stone and proceed to view & assess said damages & Make Report to the next Meeting of this board

1838 June 4th Brewood Returned allowing said Claimant Fifty Dollars damages

Same day the following is ordered to be reviewed and established as a public highway and be opened according to law to wit: Beginning in the Road on the East Side of Darby Creek on the line between Washington Lewis & Elisha Knaps & running with the said line 58 M. 142 poles South 62 poles John Johnsons 57 M. 40 poles 118 M. 32 Abraby Run 135 M. 26 poles S. E. 24 poles 13 M. 54 poles 129 E. 30 poles 175 E. 55 poles Shubb Miller 14 E. 24 poles Leander Stone, 19 E. 82 poles 118 M. 59 poles 171 E. 19 poles 155 E. 32 poles Annanias Harriell on the Road leading from the National Road up Darby Creek
